Case Summary: On 07-12-12 Utility Clerk D. Beaston found that the Gold Bar City deposits from 06-29-12 and 07-05-12 were missing.

Mayor Beavers located the deposit envelopes in the desk of City Clerk L. Kelly with a total of \$395 missing. The envelopes were left in the desk of L. Kelly with the money missing.

I had a hidden camera placed in the office of L. Kelly.

L. Kelly returned to work on 07-13-12 and reported that she found the deposit envelopes, with all of the money inside of them, between boxes and a file cabinet. She reported that they must have fallen there by accident.

On 07-17-12 I interviewed L. Kelly and she gave me the same account in verbal and written form. I confronted her with some of my investigatory findings and she admitted that she borrowed the \$395 to pay a personal bill and returned it on 07-13-12 after she learned that it was reported missing.

On 07-12-12 Gold Bar Utility Clerk Denise Beaston advised me that she and Gold Bar Mayor Joe Beavers were investigating an incident involving missing money from two deposits for the city. Beaston told me that the deposits for June 29th 2012 and July 5th 2012 were missing. She told me that she collects receipts from citizens who come in to pay bills, totals them, places them into an envelope with a printout of the total amount, and leaves them in a designated location in the finance office for City Clerk Laura Kelly to process and deposit. She told me the two deposits were missing and that she checked with the bank and found that they had not been deposited. She also told me the office was searched and the two deposits were not found.

Later the same date, Mrs. Beaston reported that the two deposit envelopes were found by Mayor Beavers in Mrs. Kelly's desk drawer. She said the envelopes were missing a total of \$395 and that each still had \$1 bills and loose change in them but bills larger than \$1 were gone.

I spoke with Mayor Beavers who said he found the envelopes in Mrs. Kelly's desk drawer and that the majority of the money was missing from each. He returned the envelopes to the drawer.

I contacted Sgt. T. Warren with the Snohomish Regional Drug and Gang Task Force to request a camera to monitor the office. He sent Detective Charles Wilfong out to install a hidden camera in the city finance office where Mrs. Kelly works. I coordinated with Mayor Beavers and Detective Wilfong to make sure that other office employees, who may have access to the deposits, would not be aware that we were installing a camera. Other employees were directed by Mayor Beavers to be out of the building for part of the afternoon. Detective Wilfong installed a pin-hole camera in a box on top of the locked cabinet where deposits are placed. Once the camera was operational, Mayor Beavers removed the deposit envelopes dated June 29th and July 5th from Mrs. Kelly's office desk and returned them in view of the camera. He verified that one was still missing \$80 and the other was missing \$315.

I periodically viewed the camera footage live, and reviewed recordings up to approximately 0740 hours on July 13th, 2012. No one other than Mrs. Kelly accessed Mrs. Kelly's desk during that time. A thunderstorm occurred that morning and the camera stopped recording footage at just after 0740, possibly due to a brief loss of power.

I spoke with Deputy J Cook later that day and he relayed to me that the money was returned by Mrs. Kelly who reported that she found it in the office.

On Monday, July 16th, I spoke with Mayor Beavers and Mrs. Beaston. I learned that Mrs. Kelly turned in the envelopes with the missing money, stating she found it between the file cabinet below the receipts cabinet and a cardboard box.

On Tuesday, July 17th, I called and left a telephone message for Mrs. Kelly stating that I wished to set up an appointment to meet with her. She returned my call shortly afterward and we agreed to meet at the Sultan Police station at 1400.

On Tuesday, July 17th, at 1400 hours, I met with Mrs. Kelly. We sat in the break/conference room so that she was close to the exit door and I was across the room, on the other side of the conference table. I told her she was free to leave and that she did not have to talk with me. I told her that I needed to advise her of her rights and that she was still free to leave. She reviewed the rights form, initialed, and signed. I asked if she understood her rights and she said she did. I asked if she was willing to waive her rights and talk to me and she said she was.

I told Mrs. Kelly that I understood that a total of \$395 was missing from two deposits, that she was notified on July 12th, and that she said she would take care of it on July 13th. I also told her that I was aware that she turned in the deposit envelopes with the money inside of them on July 13th. She said that was what happened and that she found them in the location she described to Mrs. Beaston and Public Works Director John Light. I asked if the envelopes she turned in were the same as the ones she received the deposits in and she said they were. I asked if there were any other location, other than the cabinet used for deposits, that the envelopes may have been stored. She said there was not. I asked if they would have ever been in her desk drawer and she said they would not.

I asked Mrs. Kelly if she would write a statement for me that explains how she found the money. I reminded her that it was up to her and that she was not required to write anything at all. She said she would write a statement. She did so and said she came to work, was asked to find the missing deposits, and she searched for them. She said she began searching where they are supposed to be and then around that area, moving boxes, and found them near the cabinet where they should have been secured.

After reviewing her statement, I explained to her that we found the deposit envelopes in her desk drawer on Thursday with most of the money, \$395, missing. I told her that I directed the installation of a hidden camera in her office and that the location and contents of the deposit envelopes were documented Thursday afternoon on that camera footage. I told her that the camera recorded footage of the office and was in place until Friday afternoon when Deputy J Cook removed it at my request. I told her that I knew that no one accessed the drawer where the deposit envelopes were found, except for her. I showed her one still shot, from approximately 0738 hours on Friday, July 12th 2012, that showed her sitting at her desk. I told her that this all placed me in the difficult position of having to tell her that I knew things could not have happened as she explained them.

Mrs. Kelly began to cry and said she took the money. She said "I admit it, I took the money." She cried and went on to explain that she needed it to pay a bill. She said she had been receiving calls from a creditor, threatening collections, and that she could not wait until Thursday to pay the bill so she borrowed the money from those deposits and was going to replace it right away. She was out sick this week so she did not replace it as soon as she had hoped she would. She assured me that she did not intend to keep it and that she just acted out of desperation to borrow it for a short period. She told me that she put the money in the envelopes, then placed them near the deposit cabinet, and later "found" them there in the presence of her co-workers so it would look like they were accidentally dropped.

I shared with her that I believed her. I showed her written statement to her and showed her our regular statement form, pointing out to her that the general witness statement form has a perjury clause and the one I asked her to sign does not have one. I asked her if she would be willing to write a statement now, one that we both knew was truthful, on one of our regular statement forms and to sign, under penalty of perjury, that she was being truthful. I again told her that she did not have to write the statement. She said she would do so. She completed and signed a statement saying that she borrowed the money because she was desperate to pay a bill for a training course she attended. When she was finished, she asked if she could contact Mayor Beavers to apologize. I told her that she could and that I would pass on to him that she wanted to talk with him.

I could see that she was very upset and I took time to suggest that she reach out to those who support and care for her to help her through this difficult time. She said she would do so and assured me that she was not the type who would now harm herself.

I walked her out to the exit and ended this contact with her.

I reported my findings to Mayor Joe Beavers and Lt. Jeff Brand.

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July 12, 2012

At around 9am I decided that since Laura Kelly had been out all week and I wasn't sure if she would be in on Friday, that I should probably do a deposit and have Mayor Beavers take it to the bank to be deposited. I don't typically do the deposits since I am the one doing the till reconciliation at night, but on occasion I have had to, if Laura was out or she was extremely busy and there was a number of days sitting or a large sum of money in the envelopes, but either Laura, Mayor Beavers or Sherry Doherty take them to the bank for deposit.

I pulled the deposit bag that had all the days of money in it and grabbed the reconciliation sheets that I fill out each night. As I was doing each days deposit and checking them against their days reconciliation sheet, I couldn't find the envelope that contained the checks and cash for the day of July 5th. I went back and double checked the cabinet where we keep the money to make sure that I hadn't placed it just inside the cabinet and not in the bag, I even checked the drawer below to make sure it hadn't fallen down inside. Both Joe and John looked also, just in case it was there and I just wasn't seeing it. I checked to see if maybe Laura had done a deposit for that one day, but the last deposit slip was for a deposit that had been done on June 29th for the day of June 28th, so I looked and found the reconciliation sheet for June 29th and it had not been signed off on (which is what we do once we verify that what is on the sheet matches what is in that days envelop for cash and checks). I then tried to reach Laura to see if maybe she had for some reason grabbed those two days and deposited them, but put the slips somewhere else and not signed off on the reconciliation sheets. Since I couldn't reach Laura 1 called the local Bank of America Branch in Sultan and after verifying a couple questions, was able to ask if any deposits had been made in the amounts that were listed on the two reconciliation sheets, the person on the phone said that no such deposits for those amounts had been done. When I finally got ahold of Laura and told her I couldn't find the envelopes with all the money in them for the days of June 29th and July 5th, she stated that she would take care of it tomorrow when she came in.

After letting Joe know that both June 29th and July 5th were missing, he went into Laura's office to look to see if maybe she had stuck them somewhere else at her desk, thought maybe she had gotten interrupted while getting the deposit ready and possibly stuck them somewhere else. He found two envelopes in her bottom desk drawer and brought them out to me so that I could fill out the deposit slips for those two days and he could take them into the bank to be deposited. When I took the money out for June 29th there was only \$3.38 in cash in the envelope, the cash for that day was \$83.38 so it was short by \$80.00 cash, I then checked the checks and they totaled what was on that day's reconciliation sheet. I then put the money back into the envelope and wrote on a sticky note what was in the envelope and what was missing. I then opened July 5th envelope and it had \$4.43 cash in it, which when compared to what was on that days reconciliation sheet was short by \$315.00 cash, I then calculated the checks and the total came out correct for that days checks amount. I then put the money back into the

envelope and wrote on a sticky note how much was in the envelope for cash and how much was missing in cash for that day. Joe was standing at my desk while I did all of this and John was in the office.

I have made copies of both days reconciliation sheets along with the reconciliation sheet and deposit slip for June 28th.



A couple minutes later I was in John Lights office when Laura Kelly came in and said she had found the missing envelopes from yesterday and handed me two envelopes with contents in them, they appeared to be the same ones that Joe had found in her office desk bottom drawer the day before. I peeked inside one of the envelopes and saw that there where checks along with ones and twenties and some small change, they appeared to be the same envelopes, with the exception of it now containing twenties (which were missing from the envelopes that were found in her desk) along with one dollar bills and some change, I then handed them back to her. I asked her where she had found them, John and I followed her into her office and she showed us where she had found them next to the locking cabinet (where we normally keep the money) between the cabinet and the white file boxes sitting on top of the file cabinets in her office (John Light, Joe Beavers and I had searched all of that area yesterday for the missing envelopes), she stated that she must have gotten interrupted while getting ready to do a deposit and must have just set them there. This was around 8:15-8:30am.
