#### Vehicle in Motion (Initial Observations, Observation of Stop)

On 08-26-17 at 1626 hours Washington State Patrol (WSP) communications advised of a 1 car collision with a barrier that was facing the wrong way on Northbound I-405. I was headed home after finishing up an overtime detail at the intersection of I-90 and state route 18. I was in the area that the call was stated to be and continued towards the location of the collision. I approached and observed 2 vehicles in the express lanes and left shoulder stopped. I observed a white comcast van with yellow hazard lights activated and directly in front of it I observed a black 2000 Toyota MR2. The toyota was facing the wrong way on the freeway and I could see clear skid marks from lane 2 across all lanes and directed at the barrier where the vehicle had made impact.

I contacted the drivers of both vehicles at the same time. I asked the defendant who was later identified via her Washington State Driver license as Ms. Dingledy, Mary if the black Toyota was her vehicle, she stated it was and then walked back towards her vehicle. I asked the driver of the Comcast van if he had seen the collision. The driver identified himself to me as Mr. Morris, Christopher. He stated that he had observed the collision; he stated he saw smoke from the defendant's vehicle as she was braking hard, he then observed the vehicle cross all lanes and strike the concrete barrier. Mr. Morris pulled in behind the defendant and activated his hazard lights and contacted the defendant who he identified as the driver of the vehicle. I collected Mr. Morris' contact information and then had him leave the scene so I could move my patrol car closer to the defendant's vehicle.

After I dismissed Mr. Morris I asked the defendant if she would stay in her vehicle for her safety so she would not be walking up and down the freeway. She was the sole occupant of the vehicle she admitted to being the driver and was also the registered owner of the car. I asked Ms. Dingledy what had happened that was caused her to be facing the wrong way on the freeway. She explained to me that she was cut off by another vehicle and swerved to avoid the other vehicle. She then stated she didn't know what happened after that. I asked if she was struck by the other vehicle and she stated no. Upon leaning in closer to Ms. Dingledy to hear her over the freeway traffic I detected an odor of intoxicants coming from her I also observed that her eyes were bloodshot and watery. I had to ask her a second time to stay in the car for her safety as she tried to open the door to get out while I was standing at her window. I asked her where her keys for the vehicle were and she picked them up and showed them to me stating she had them. I stated the vehicle was going to have to be towed because I assumed it wasn't drivable. Ms. Dingledy stated "it might be" I informed her that I wanted her to leave the vehicle off for now. I asked her to wait with the vehicle while I walked back to my patrol car to reposition it to give us better cover after the Comcast van had left the scene.

I walked back to my patrol car and verified that the second unit was still on the way to provide additional cover for my scene. We were in a curve of the roadway and traffic was still passing at freeway speeds. After sitting down in my patrol vehicle the defendant exited her vehicle and began walking towards my patrol car. I stepped out of my car and stated to her that I had asked her to stay in her vehicle for safety. She stated "I know". I asked her how much alcohol she had had to drink that evening and she stated that she had been at a wine tasting. I told her that I smelled the odor of intoxicants coming from her and she stated "yes you are". I asked Ms. Dingledy if she would be willing to do some voluntary field sobriety tests so that I knew she was safe to drive. She stated "no but I'll do the PBT". I asked her if there was any reason why she didn't want to do any of the other tests and she stated "uhhh no". I observed that Ms. Dingledy's speech was fast and repetitive she asked me the same questions multiple times all evening. She would sometimes ask me the same question even just a few moments later. She asked 3 times if she could text her friend who was a witness to the collision even though I told her she could in a few minutes; she asked me where I lived at least 3 times. The defendant also asked me at least 3 times if I was going to follow up and interview Mr. Morris, I informed her every time that yes I would, but that I wasn't going to be doing that until after I was done with our process. I also observed that her movements seemed off, they were exaggerated and quick, she did a couple little skips and jumps around her car and seemed very energetic she spoke very quickly and often interrupted me even as I was answering questions she was asking.

Pre-Arrest Screening (Field Sobriety Tests, Preliminary Breath Test)

All standardized field sobriety tests were refused.

#### PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST (PBT)

I retrieved the PBT from my patrol vehicle and contacted the defendant again. I asked her if she was taking any type of medications and she stated no. I asked if she used any drugs, and she stated no. I held the PBT up and performed the blank test. I stated this is the PBT machine and the defendant interrupted me and stated "I know what a PBT is". I informed her that the test was "voluntary and doesn't replace an evidentiary breath test". I asked her when the last time she had something to eat was she stated noon. I asked her if she ate or drank anything within the last 15 minutes and she said no. I instructed her that I wanted her to take a deep breath in and blow out hard for about 5 to 7 seconds. I raised the PBT up to her mouth and she awkwardly pulled her lips under her teeth and did not make a complete seal around the PBT straw. She then proceeded to blow out for approximately 1 to 2 seconds. The defendant blew for only 1 to 2 seconds 4 times, I kept instructing her to blow harder and provide a longer breath sample. She stated she was blowing, however I had the back of my hand right up next to the back end of the PBT straw, I could feel air start come out but only last for the approximate 1 to 2 seconds before she would stop. I informed her that I hadn't hit the button that activates the PBT vet because I was feeling such a low amount of air coming through the backside of the PBT straw. I provided more coaching on how to properly provide her breath sample and gave her another attempt. She again provided a weak air flow. I stopped and asked her if there was a reason she didn't want to blow hard. She remained adamant that she was blowing. I gave her one last attempt and activated the PBT even though it was another very shallow breath sample.

While waiting for the PBT to produce a result I asked the defendant again if she had wine tasted that evening. She said yes. I asked her if that was all she did, she said yes. I asked her how long she had been wine tasting and she stated from 2:30 to about 5:30. I asked the defendant if she was aware what the legal limit for alcohol was in Washington and she quickly answered yes, I asked her what it was and she stated .08. I asked her how much did she think she drank. She stated "I don't know". I showed her the PBT and stated that it was still counting up but that it was already at a 0.100 AT 1836 hours. I informed her that she was over the legal limit by 0.02. She stated I'm sorry about that. I stated I was placing her under arrest for DUI.

Arrest (Handcuffing, Searching, Constitutional Rights)

I placed her under arrest for DUI at 1837 hours. She began asking me questions about her vehicle and kept trying to turn to face me. I stated "ma'am you are under arrest" and finished placing the handcuffs on her. I informed her that I had to read her her rights but that I would then be happy to answer any questions she may have. I read her Miranda Warnings from my department issued card at 1838 hours. I then performed a search of the defendant, while searching her she stated she was sorry I had to deal with her. I then placed her in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

Before leaving the scene, the defendant asked me to retrieve some items from her vehicle for her. She requested that I retrieve her phone, credit cards and a black bag just behind her driver seat.

Trooper C. Dehart #500 arrived on scene and stayed with the Defendant's vehicle until the Tow truck arrived to retrieve Ms. Dingledy's car. While I was writing up the Tow form the defendant asked me if I was King County or Snohomish County. I informed her that I was a Washington State Trooper. She stated she knew that and replied "are we were going to Mill Creek or where are you going." I informed her that we were going back to Seattle. She asked "is there any way you can go to Mill Creek?" I informed her that based on where we were and I even pointed out a sign a few hundred feet in front of us that stated "now entering Snohomish County". I then informed her I was a King County Trooper and that we would be staying in King County.

I asked Ms. Dingledy if she had ever been arrested for a DUI before and she stated "no". I asked her why she seemed so familiar with the DUI process. She stated "because I was a public defender for a very long time." I asked why she opted to do the PBT but not the Field sobriety tests. She stated "I did because I don't believe that I am intoxicated but you and I might have a difference of opinion".

The defendant asked if she could use her phone to let a friend of hers who was at the next exit off of the freeway know that he didn't need to wait for her. I informed her that I would let her contact him in about 10 or 15 minutes. She then asked me that question again only a few minutes later. I informed her that I would let her contact him once we got down to the office.

#### Administrative Process (BAC and Disposition)

I transported the defendant from the scene to the WSP district headquarters in Bellevue. Upon arrival and entering the B.A.C. room I asked the defendant if she had any substances in her mouth I also asked her to open her mouth and raise her tongue. I changed the cuffs from behind her back to in front of her so she could send a text message to the individual she wanted to notify of her arrest. Ms. Dingledy asked if there was any way she could have a glass of water. I stated that she couldn't have anything to eat or drink or even touch her mouth during the 15 minutes observation period. I read the defendant her Miranda Warnings a second time and asked if she wanted to sign that they had been read to her. She signed. I then read the next line that stated she was declining to exercise her rights at this time and asked if she wanted to sign. She stated that she would sign but didn't want to answer any questions. I placed the pen and paper in the same place I did the first time when she signed but she didn't pick up the pen and sign on the second line I waited about 10 seconds and then picked the paper up and continued on with the process.

I read the Implied Consent Warnings from the DUI packet word for word without skipping any portion. After reading the implied consent warnings I asked the defendant if she was willing to sign that they had been read to her and she consented. I asked her if she would be willing to provide a breath sample and she stated she would. I observed the defendant as we sat face to face throughout the entire duration of the 15 minute observation period. I utilized that time to provide coaching on how I wanted the defendant to provide a breath sample. I informed her that unlike the PBT she was going to need to provide a steady consistent breath sample of approximately 10 seconds. I informed her that I would see condensation in the plastic tube as well as hear the tone produced by the BAC machine if she was breathing air into it. The defendant seemed to not believe me and was dismissing my statements saying "I know" and "the PBT worked fine".

Upon attempting to use the BAC machine the defendant again started by providing only a 1 to 2 second breath sample before she would stop blowing. Every time she stopped blowing I replaced the plastic nozzle with a new one and instructed her to blow again. After several attempts we got the first breath sample. Once the machine was ready we began to attempt the second breath sample. The defendant had to try more than once for this breath sample as well and made the comment "Jesus Christ I've never had so much fun giving a blow job...sorry...I'm sorry" I stated that was awkward and the defendant stated you've never heard that one before? I stated that I hadn't.

#### Breath/Blood Testing:

The defendant didn't have anything to eat, drink, smoke, or vomit during the observation period.

The BAC thermometer was within the required range of 34° C +/ - .2° C.

The RFI antenna was present, and breath tube was warm/hot to the touch.

The external standard was within the required range of .072 to .088.

The defendant provided 2 successful breath samples the first was a .122 and the second was a .115.

After the B.A.C. process I transported the defendant from District Headquarters to King County Corrections where I booked her into jail. While in the jail entrance area the defendant motioned to the bag of hers that I was holding and stated I can't believe you have that bag. I asked her wasn't this the bag you asked me to grab. She stated yes, but that I didn't know what she did for a living. I said well you said you were a public defender. She said she used to be a public defender. The jail staff emptied the defendant's bag onto their counter while booking her and pulled out and held up what I had earlier thought was just a coat. It now appeared to be a black judge's robe. The Officer at the jail then pulled out the folders from inside the bag and pointed out to me that one of the cover sheets had the defendants name on it and listed her as a judge. I left the scene and contacted WSP communications and notified them that the defendant was a Superior Court Judge and asked if they would notify a supervisor.

I proceeded to the WSP Roanoke office where I typed this report and submitted my hard drive with video into the hard drive storage locker before going off of shift for the evening.

The only outstanding statements I need to collect as of 1144 hours on 08-26-17 are the witness statement from Mr. Morris and a phone call to the other witness who's information was provided by the defendant. The other witness was identified by the defendant as Mr. Baldwin, Brian.


