## Narrative

### NARRATIVE:

The victim has requested anonymity in this investigation. Of the following individuals, Matheson, Okoloko, Juhl, Cummings, Hunter, Hupp, Sugg, Dickinson, RP1 and Mahjoubian are deputy prosecutors in Snohomish County. Matheson is the Chief Deputy Prosecuting Attorney. RP2 and Eco are also employed by Snohomish County.

Tuesday, July 3, 2018, at about 1440 hours, I (Detective Grant) was working a patrol shift in the Chelan area. Rivercom advised of an assault complaint. The RP was requesting a phone call. Soon after I answered the call I received a phone call from Undersheriff Mathews. He said the call was likely related to a couple of arrests that were made during the WAPA conference in Chelan.

I called the reporting party. She asked for anonymity as a victim and will be referred to as RP1 in this report. RP1 is an adult female. Her full name and contact information are known to me. RP1 described an incident of "groping" which had occurred while she was in a room at the Grandview in Chelan. She said she knew officers from the Snohomish County Sheriff's Office and they would be available to take her statement. I told her I would prefer to take her statement and I would be available to meet her in Everett on the following Monday. We made plans to meet there.

I interviewed RP1 at the Snohomish County Administration Building. The interview was audio-recorded.

June 20, 2018, RP1 went to the WAPA conference in Chelan. After classes, she visited with friends and co-workers at a hospitality room. The conference and hospitality room were at Campbell's Resort in Chelan. She had a glass of red wine. After the room closed, she and several friends and co-workers went to the Stormy Mountain Brewery in Chelan. They ate dinner. While she was there, RP1 consumed one lite beer and just a bit from another beer. A deputy prosecutor from Snohomish County, Chris Dickinson was at the dinner with his girlfriend, RP2. (Because RP2 has asked for anonymity as the victim of a related and cross-referenced investigation, she will be referred to as RP2. Her name and contact information are known to me. She is an adult female.) During dinner, he teased RP1 by asking her for a "high five." RP1 was confused by it and said he was too far away for it to have been physically possible. At some point during the dinner, Dickinson threw some lime wedges at RP1.

After dinner, a group decided to go to Edirin Okoloko's room at the Grandview (room #525). Initially, Okoloko, RP1, Dickinson, RP2, and Craig Matheson went to the room. Okoloko and Matheson left the room to get ice and RP1 unexpectedly found herself alone with Dickinson and RP2. Because RP1 had heard stories about Dickinson and RP2 being swingers and possibly looking for a third party, because RP2 and Dickinson were together on the couch and because they had reason to know each other from work where Dickinson in general made her uncomfortable, RP1 ran out of the room. She had left her purse behind. She ran into Matt Hunter and his girlfriend, Debbie Eco in the parking lot. RP1, Hunter, and Eco went back to the room and when they arrived Matheson and Okoloko were there.

People were getting drinks and going out on the deck. At some point, Nate Sugg, John Juhl, Kirk Mahjoubian, and Jon Cummings came to the room. They also went out on the deck to socialize. There was a round table and some chairs on the deck. RP1 stayed inside out of the smoke. Nate Sugg asked her to help him move an ottoman onto the deck for additional seating. She was walking backwards onto

the deck. Dickinson was seated in a chair to her left. RP1 felt a hand come under her left arm and squeeze her breast very hard. Simultaneously, she felt a hand come around her right side to her waist and pull her backward. RP1 saw that it was Dickinson and he was trying to pull her onto his lap. She yelled and said "gross" or "he's trying to grab my boob" or something similar. She jumped behind Matt Hunter and hid. She waited for Nate to move so she could get through the door.

She went back to her room. She changed her clothes. RP1 told me she changed was because the clothes smelled like smoke. She changed into a sweat outfit. She decided to go back to the room and just stay away from Dickinson which was what she "had planned originally."

RP1 told Eco and Sugg Dickinson had groped her. She also told Craig Matheson and Hal Hupp. Matheson, who is in a supervisory position, said "We can't be having that." She went to her room but did not sleep well. RP1 was going to confront Dickinson and tell him it was inappropriate and never to happen again. Okoloko agreed to go with her. Dickinson did not show up at class so the confrontation did not occur. (Dickinson was taken into law enforcement custody later in the evening, see 18C-06826).

When I asked how she felt, RP1 said she was disgusted, violated, angry, unable to use her hands because they were busy (holding the ottoman), vulnerable, bent over, defenseless and he wanted to grab her breast and got to do it. She said, "I was a piece of meat." She couldn't see it coming and couldn't stop it. She'd worked with him and couldn't believe it. She felt sick.

RP1 described Dickinson and RP2 as very touchy feely, very together. RP2 was flirty with everyone. Their behavior was sexualized (my term). She thought Dickinson had no boundaries at all. She has not talked to him since.

I heard that one other person had witnessed the assault, Debbie Eco. Eco was interviewed next and the interview was audio-recorded. (The other witnesses were interviewed by phone.)

Eco said while they were at dinner at Stormy Mountain Dickinson threw crumpled napkins at her. She thought it was flirtatious. Earlier, he had been friendly to her at the hospitality room. She's known him for twenty years and they've only had about ten words together. When they left Stormy Mountain, she and her boyfriend Matt Hunter drove to the Grandview to go to Okoloko's room. They met up with RP1 in the parking lot. She said, "Oh my God they left me in there." RP1 said it was awkward. RP1 explained Matheson and Okoloko left her in the room with RP2 and Dickinson. Apparently, RP2 and Dickinson were getting a little "excited" on the couch.

Eco, Hunter, and RP1 went to the room. Eco saw RP2 was on Dickinson's lap. More people came in and more alcohol was going down. RP2 and Dickinson were "plastered." There was a group on the deck. Hunter and Juhl were on the rail. Eco was looking out from the sliding door, and RP2 was getting "crazy" sexually dancing. Eco was mad because RP2 was next to her boyfriend. She thought it was "drunken" dancing. Hunter was talking to another person and wasn't paying attention to RP2. Nate and RP1 were pulling the ottoman out. There was a bench where Dickinson was sitting. Eco saw Chris's arm go around RP1's top part and pull her down on his lap. RP1 had a look of terror on her face. RP1 jumped over the ottoman and went behind Hunter and hunkered down. RP1 was saying, "He just grabbed my boob - he just grabbed my boob!" or something to that effect. RP1 said, "Debbie saw it!" but Eco said she had seen the arm go around her and him



pulling on RP1 but was not in a position to see the hand on the breast. Eco believed RP1 "completely" because RP1 had made the accusation immediately after the assault. RP1 stood there a few minutes and went back into the living room. Eco went into the living room and talked with her. RP1 was clearly bothered. RP1 said no one had ever touched her like that when it wasn't something she'd wanted. Eco said RP1 went back to her room because she felt icky. Eco has known Dickinson a long time. He has never done anything to her but he makes her very uncomfortable. She had also heard rumors about Dickinson and RP2 looking for a third person. She'd heard it two or three times that night. Eco said the behavior between Dickinson and RP2 made the others uncomfortable.

I spoke by phone with Matt Hunter at about 1645 hours July 16, 2018. He had heard what happened from his girlfriend Debbie Eco. Eco told him Dickinson grabbed RP1 and tried to pull her onto his lap. There was no mention of breasts at that time. Hunter heard RP1 hid behind him after the assault but did not recall that himself. Hunter then heard more of what had happened from Hal Hupp and understood why RP1 was upset.

I spoke by phone with Hal Hupp early on July 17, 2018. He arrived at the hotel room not long before things broke up. RP1 told him what had happened. Afterward they spoke with Craig Matheson.

RP1 told Hupp that she and Sugg were moving an ottoman. She was bent over to lift and move the ottoman. She said she was grabbed by Dickinson and demonstrated him grabbing her left breast with his left hand. She said he pulled her onto his lap and Hupp said she may not have made it all the way to his lap.

Hupp had the impression RP1 was shocked and processing what had happened. By class the next day she had gotten angry.

After Hupp, I spoke with Jon Cummings. Cummings was invited to the room by Edirin Okoloko. Cummings thought Okoloko and RP1 might be both staying in the room and co-hosting the get together. (RP1 was staying in another room.) He did not have much recollection of Dickinson and RP2 and heard about the events a week later. Cummings said Dickinson had been drinking and he saw RP2 for the first time. She was very intoxicated. Cummings has not talked to RP1 or Dickinson since the incident. He was not surprised by the allegations.

I spoke with Edirin Okoloko. He rented the room where the incident occurred. After dinner he invited some of his co-workers to his room. He did not specifically invite Dickinson and RP2 (and did not prevent them from attending). At the time of the assault, he was on the balcony on the opposite side from Dickinson and RP2. Some other deputy prosecutors came to his room after dark. In his peripheral vision, he could see RP1 and Sugg moving the ottoman onto the deck. He did not see the assault. After, he noticed RP1 had left his room.

After a while RP1 returned to the room. On the deck, Okoloko heard some tapping on the sliding door glass. It was RP1. When she got his attention she pointed to RP2 and Dickinson. RP2 was on Dickinson's lap and her breasts were exposed. Both appeared asleep. Okoloko woke them and told them she needed to cover and they needed to leave.

After RP2 and Dickinson left, Okoloko learned about the groping incident. RP1 told him Dickinson had grabbed her and pulled her onto him. RP1 was very disturbed by what had happened. Okoloko asked her why she hadn't told him. She said she was shocked and she went back to her room. Okoloko was not sure if she

had changed clothes while she was gone.

The following day (Thursday, June 21) she told Okoloko she had not been able to sleep. RP1 wanted to confront Dickinson. Okoloko offered to go with her. They didn't see Dickinson the following day. After the morning class, she told Okoloko that Dickinson had grabbed her "boob" very hard and squeezed it. She said she was shocked and said she had been taken advantage of because she was in a vulnerable position while moving the ottoman.

I spoke with Nate Sugg. He said he had asked RP1 to move an ottoman onto the deck to make additional seating. As they were going out the door to the deck, Juhl and then Dickinson were seated to his right. The others were along the rail or to his left. Dickinson had stood up. RP1 dropped the ottoman as if startled. Juhl and then Dickinson put their feet on the stool. Sugg and RP1 went back inside. RP1 told him Dickinson had grabbed her. RP1 used her left hand to demonstrate her breast being grabbed. Sugg said she was startled, shocked and offended. He spoke with RP1 and then talked with both RP1 and Eco. Sugg said he knew the incident would be bigger.

I spoke with John Juhl. Juhl had gotten up at four am and played 18 holes of golf before the evening. He'd consumed some alcohol. He slept through much of the party.

I spoke with RP2 about a separate incident. She gave me a phone number for Dickinson. I called the number on July 19 and left a message. The call has not been returned. I have heard that he has hired an attorney and is not likely to return my call.

I spoke with Craig Matheson on July 25. He said he did not witness the incident between RP1 and Dickinson but was told about it afterward. He said he intended to handle the situation when he returned to work on Monday.



## Yahyavi/Dickenson investigation

### SUMMARY OF INVESTIGATION

I conducted 16 interviews into the allegations of misconduct by three members of the office alleged to have been committed during off duty hours at the WAPA summer conference held June 20-22, 2018 in Chelan Washington. The interviews were conducted over 5 days between June 25-29. The investigation concerned three acts of misconduct alleged to have been committed by Chris Dickinson, one act of misconduct alleged to have been committed by Kirk Mahjoubian, and one act of misconduct alleged to have been committed by Bob Hendrix. Only the two acts of misconduct alleged to have been committed by Dickinson has been corroborated. The third act is not corroborated, although there is circumstantial evidence that he could have committed that act, but perhaps unintentionally. The act by Mahjoubian was corroborated in part and not corroborated in part. The act alleged to have been committed by Hendrix was not corroborated.

### DICKINSON

Chris attended a social hour, dinner, and after dinner gathering with his girlfriend Leigh Kellogg. They were both drinking and were highly intoxicated by the time they arrived at the after dinner gathering at Edirin Okoloko's hotel room. During the course of the evening while Francesca Yahyavi was helping Nate Sugg pull an ottoman out onto the deck Chris reached over and grabbed Francesca from behind, and attempted to pull her onto his lap. While doing that he grabbed one of her breasts and squeezed. Debbie Eco saw Chris grab Francesca around her chest area and try to pull her onto his lap.

At one point while there were a number of people on the deck Leigh was sitting in Chris's lap. She appeared to have passed out. It is not clear whether Chris was passed out or not. Chris had his arms around Leigh's midsection. Leigh's breasts were exposed. Originally it was reported that Chris had intentionally lifted Leigh's bra and pulled down her shirt to expose Leigh's breasts. Investigation revealed that no one actually saw this happen. That report is most likely the result of supposition by Kirk Mahjoubian when relaying the events of the night before to some other colleagues who were not present. However, before her breast became exposed Craig saw Chris rubbing or fondling Leigh's breasts. Leigh described wearing ill-fitting clothing that night. It is possible that in fondling her breasts her top was moved and her breasts exposed. No one was paying any attention to Chris or Leigh during the course of that portion of the evening however, and mostly people had their backs to Chris and Leigh so it is not clear how her breasts got exposed.

The investigation also revealed that Chris had a picture of Leigh as the screensaver on his cell phone. Chris had been showing other members of the office the picture. Kameon Quillen confirmed this. The picture depicted Leigh sprawled on a bed with ties on her wrists as if she was or had been tied up at one point. She wore a top and high heels, but was otherwise naked from the waist down. Her legs were opened enough that you could see her crotch. Chris manufactured at least one opportunity to show the picture to an advocate, Kameon Quillen, by saying he wanted to show her a picture of his boat. He did not unlock the phone and pull up a picture of the boat before handing the phone to Kameon. Instead he just gave the phone to Kameon locked, so that she would see the screensaver. Leigh was aware of the picture, but not aware that Chris was showing the picture to co-workers. She had not given him permission to do that, and would not have given him permission to do that.



## MAHJOURIAN

Kirk took two pictures of Leigh sitting on Chris's lap with her breasts exposed. The first picture showed just Leigh, Chris, and John Juhl, with parts of Jon Cummings' and Matt Hunter's arms in the foreground. Hal Hupp is also in the foreground facing away from Chris and Leigh. The second picture showed Matt Hunter and Jon Cummings in the foreground. Kirk later showed the picture to Laura Harmon and Adam Sturdivant the next day. He showed Hal Hupp one of the pictures the night of the incident after Chris and Leigh left. It does not appear that anyone directed Kirk to take the picture, and people were generally not aware that there were two pictures taken.

There was an initial question about why Kirk took the picture and what role Matt and Jon had in the picture taking. Initially there was a concern that the picture was taken as a prank, making fun of Leigh and Chris. There was also a concern that Matt Hunter was somehow endorsing the joke by posing with his thumb up, indicating that there was something funny about Leigh's condition.

In speaking to Matt I learned that he was not thinking about what was going on in the background. He saw that Kirk was taking pictures. He happened to be standing next to Jon talking to him so they posed to have their picture taken as anyone would in the context of a party that they were having fun at. It was only the next morning when Matt considered that Leigh and Chris might be in the background when he suggested to Kirk that for Leigh's sake that Kirk delete the photo.

In speaking to Kirk I learned that Kirk took the picture because he blamed Chris for Leigh's breasts being exposed, and he was upset that Chris would get away with that kind of misconduct because Chris was a senior deputy. He thought there might be an investigation later however, and thought that photo documentation would support the claims of a group of people whose credibility could be questioned because they had all been drinking. Jason Cummings talked to Kirk before I talked to him. Jason did not agree that Kirk's motives were that clear cut. However in talking with Laura Harmon and Adam Sturdivant, who both spoke to Kurt before Jason spoke to Kurt, it appears that Kirk was upset by what he saw, and wanted to make sure someone knew about it.

## HENDRIX

Francesca reported that the day after Chris grabbed her she was at a Bar-b-Que after classes when she was talking to Mike Boska and Bob Hendrix. When Boska asked Hendrix to move closer to him Hendrix said something to the effect that he didn't want Frannie to accuse him of grabbing her. The three were talking about what the outcome of the assault would be and Hendrix said something to her like "well it's not like you are going to get him fired are you?"

Neither Boska nor Hendrix corroborate Frannie's account of what Hendrix said to her. Rather they both indicate that Hendrix expressed appropriate concern for her. They both also indicated to me that Hendrix was very uncomfortable talking about it. The only thing Bob thought could have been misinterpreted was when he asked Frannie if the touching was invited. He asked her that because he was not sure exactly what the circumstances of the touching were. As soon as Frannie said no, he backed off talking about the circumstances.

Below is a summary of the investigation.

June 25, 2018

Diane Kremenich alerted me to an issue involving Frannie at the WAPA Chelan conference this morning. I was told to go talk to Frannie. Frannie explained to me what happened Wednesday night with Dickenson touching her breasts as he came up behind her while she was helping Sugg move a table outside onto the patio. She told me Debbie Eco saw the incident. Then she told me the next day that Boska was sitting next to her and saw Hendrix. Hendrix was not at the party the night before. Boska asked Hendrix to come and sit next to them. Hendrix demurred saying he didn't want Frannie to accuse him of grabbing her. She was offended, he then said something to the effect of well you would not get him fired would you?

Talked to Marie G. and Charlotte C. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Marie had already been contacted by Craig Matheson on Friday, so she was aware of it. Marie was going to talk to Jason and Steve [REDACTED]

about 2:30 I got back from juvenile court. – Jason and Marie approached me and informed me that I was appointed to investigate this matter. Jason left to go talk to Kirk Mahjoubian about some collateral issue re: this situation and him taking pictures of Leigh Kellogg exposed. I talked to Marie about the [REDACTED] Then went to find Frannie. She was talking to Sugg so I waited until she finished with him.

I met with Frannie about 3:15 – she gave me a detailed statement of what happened. Went to talk to Craig Matheson at 4. Talked to Nate Sugg about 4:45. Craig and Nate corroborated a lot of what Frannie said.

June 26, 2018

I met with Jon Cummings, Kirk Mahjoubian, Mike Boska, Debbie Eco, and Matt Hunter, and Hal Hupp and took statements from them. Hal was the first one to tell me that Chris had a photo of Leigh on his cell phone screensaver. It showed Leigh from the naked from the waist down in a sexual pose. Hal had not seen the photo himself, but reported that Robert Grant and Kameon Quillian had seen the photo and described it to Hal. Jason Cummings helped get Debbie Eco into his office for the interview and stayed for the interview, helping out asking some follow up questions. Jon Cummings and Kirk Mahjoubian had Nate Sugg present for their interviews as their union rep. I also called Edirin Okoloko who was working from home and took a statement by phone from him. Based on my discussion with Kirk I decided I needed to talk to Laura Harmon too.

Up to this point I had taken notes and told the witness that I would draft a typewritten statement for their review and edits. When the draft was edited I would incorporate those edits and have them do a final review and if necessary edit and then ask them to date and sign it. Since the interview with Jon happened in my office I just typed his statement as he talked to me. I gave him a copy of the draft which he took back to his office, edited, signed, and emailed back to me.

Around 7:30 p.m. Mark called me on my personal cell to talk about the investigation. He informed me that he intended to have Chris put on admin leave and he was also going to put Kirk on admin leave. At that time there was some information that the photos that Kirk took were done for laughs. Given that

rumor Mark was upset that Kirk would have taken photos of a woman who was unconscious while her breasts were exposed. I told Mark that my investigation did not show that Kirk did that for laughs. Rather it was outrage that a senior deputy could engage in that kind of behavior and there would be no repercussions. Mark indicated that Jason's conversation with Kirk was a little different. I told him I thought that was because Jason was upset when he confronted Kirk, and Kirk's responses may have been a result of the tone Jason took with him. We discussed whether it was necessary to put Kirk on admin leave at this point in time.

June 27, 2018

I spoke to Laura Harmon, Bob Hendrix, and John Juhl this morning. Based on my discussion with Laura Harmon I decided I needed to talk to Adam Sturdivant too. I had a brief discussion with Adam. I tried to talk to Robert Grant but he was on paternity leave.

I went to Nate Sugg's office to see if I could talk to Kirk Mahjoubian again to clarify Laura Harmon's report that Kirk said Chris intentionally exposed Leigh's breasts. Nate called Kirk on the phone and we spoke on the speaker. Kirk stated that his conversation with Laura was not official, and he may not have been as precise about what he saw and heard in that conversation as was being in the official investigation. He stated that if Laura said Chris intentionally did expose Leigh's breasts he probably did say that. But he reconfirmed that he did not actually see that happened.

While I was talking to Juhl Mark Roe came by and poked his head in the door. He didn't stay but when I finished talking to John I went to Mark's office. Adam Cornell was present. I advised Mark that I thought he should follow the advice of the civil attorneys [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] While we were talking about the investigation and I was updating Mark and Adam Cornell as to what I had learned so far, Bob Lenz called Mark and informed him that there had been a new development. Bob asked Mark to come over to Jason Cummings office. Mark invited Adam and me to attend the meeting as well.

When we got to Jason's office Craig Matheson and Bob Lenz were present. Later on during that meeting Marie Gallagher arrived. Before Marie got there Bob informed us that he had served Chris with the administrative leave letter and that Chris had left the county campus and was told not to return or talk to anyone without getting permission to do so first. Bob then said when he got back to his office he got a call from the Chelan police telling him that they had a problem with the Snohomish County Prosecutor's Office. Bob said the officer from Chelan told him that Leigh had been arrested for boating while under the influence early in the morning of June 21. Chris Dickinson was there and he tried to interfere with the investigation. He was allowed to leave after she was arrested. A little later Chris showed up at the police station and parked in the law enforcement only parking space. When an officer recognized him he asked Chris if Chris had driven there, because Chris looked drunk too. Chris denied driving there. He claimed a friend had driven him there and walked away, but refused to name the friend that drove him there. Chris was seated in the driver's seat of the car with the keys in the ignition. Chris was arrested for Physical Control and booked. It became clear at that point why Chris did not go to any of the classes on Thursday.

The discussion at that point revolved [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] Those matters would be dealt with after my investigation had been completed. We went through what I had learned so far in my investigation. I

was going to interview Leigh Kellogg and Chris Dickinson last and had yet to interview them. Based on all the information we had at that time it was decided that I did not need to talk to Chris. There was some discussion about whether and how Leigh should be informed about the pictures that were taken of her. It was decided that she should be told, and treated as a victim just as Frannie had been treated. She should be told that whether to report the incident was up to her, but if she did report that we would cooperate with whatever investigation happened.

Marie [REDACTED]

I spent the rest of the day working on typing drafts of statements for people. Mark dropped by my office in the afternoon and gave me copies of the Chelan police reports that had been sent to the office.

June 28, 2018

I reviewed the Chelan police reports detailing the arrests of Leigh Kellogg for boating while under the influence and Chris Dickinson for Physical Control.

I began working on drafting witness statements. I had an appointment with Kameon Quillian to talk about Chris's cell phone screen saver. Kameon met me in my office at 9:30 a.m. I prepared Kameon's statement in the same way I prepared Jon's statement. Kameon confirmed what Hal said about the photo. She said that Chris had come into her office saying he wanted to show her a picture of his new boat. Instead of unlocking the phone and pulling up the picture Chris just handed Kameon the phone with the screensaver on it. Kameon asked if Leigh knew about the picture and was ok with it. Chris said he thought it was artistic. Chris never did show Kameon a picture of the boat. The circumstances suggest that the boat was just a ruse to be able to show off his picture of Leigh to Kameon.

Later that day Jason and Marie came into my office and told me that I had been nominated to meet with Leigh and tell her about the photos. I wanted to have someone from the office present for that interview as Jason had been present for the interview with Debbie. Later I met with Steve Bladek who talked to me about [REDACTED] Steve was going to coordinate with the Human Resources supervisor at Juvenile court to interview Leigh. We had hoped to be able to interview her on this afternoon. Leigh was working off site that afternoon and would not be back until the next day. An interview was scheduled for 8:00 a.m. on June 29. The purpose of the interview was to advise Leigh about the photographs, determine whether she knew that she had been photographed, and determine whether she knew how her breasts became exposed. I was also told that Leigh was to be treated like Frannie was in regard to advising her that she could file a complaint with the police in Chelan or Everett if she chose to. It was completely her decision, and we would cooperate with any investigation that took place as a result of any report that she chose to file.

Late in the day I re-contacted Craig Matheson to clarify some of the things that he told me. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED]

June 29, 2018

I met with Leigh, her union rep, and Steve at the Juvenile court administration conference room. There was a preliminary discussion with juvenile administration and Leigh that Steve and I were not a part of. Steve and I were then escorted into the conference room and I interviewed Leigh. I informed her that I

wanted to focus on the time spent at Edirin's. I told her that I understood that there were some other things that she was dealing with later that evening, but I was interested in knowing what happened at Edirin's. When I informed Leigh that her breasts had been exposed during the gathering at Edirin's and that someone took a picture of is she was very upset and started crying. She knew about the photo of Chris on his cell phone but did not know that he was showing that picture to his co-workers. She was also upset when I told her about Chris doing that. I explained that she had the option of filing a complaint in regard to either incident and that we would cooperate in any case that resulted in it. I also informed her that the photos had been secured at this point and Steve and I said we would do what we could to ensure the photos did not become public. Leigh indicated that she did not want to file a complaint with the police for either incident. I wrote out notes and later typed them into a statement, which Leigh reviewed and signed.

I got every statement that I drafted reviewed and finalized by the end of business today except for Edirin Okoloko. He wanted to retype the statement himself. I left his office to do that, but he had not completed his statement by the end of business today.

July 1, 2018

I called Edirin and left a message about 8:30 asking if he had his statement completed. at 9:15 Edirin called and said he would bring it by my office.

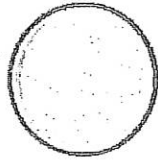
I looked on line to see if I could nail down some of the time line a little better. Most describe going to Edirin's when it was still light, or dusk out. It was dark when the grabbing and exposure incidents happened. Time and date website shows that sunset was at 9:01 P.M. on June 20, 2018 in Wenatchee, which was the closest town to Chelan listed on that website. It looks like dusk probably ended around 10:38 p.m. A copy of the printout is attached.

# 🇺🇸 Wenatchee, Washington, USA — Sunrise, Sunset, and Daylength, June 2018

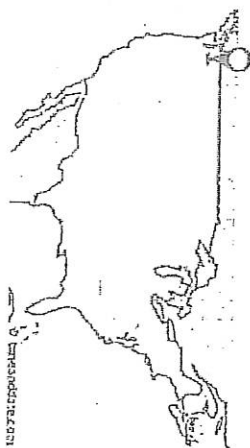

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## Statement of Francesca Yahyavi

I attended WAPA summer conference training from June 20-22 in Chelan, Washington. The conference was held at Campbell's. Classes on Wednesday went from 1:00 p.m. to about 5:00 p.m. There was a WAPA sponsored hospitality gathering about one hour after classes on Wednesday that I went to had ended. In between time I checked into my room and settled in.

I do not know Chris Dickenson well except to say hi when we happened to see each other. My first contact with Chris and his girlfriend Leigh Kellogg was at the hospitality room Wednesday night. I was talking to Adam Sturdivant and his wife and Edirin Okoloko inside the suite where the gathering was hosted. Chris came up to me and invited me out to the deck to talk to him and his girlfriend. I thought that was odd that he would invite me out since I don't know either of them well. I did eventually go out onto the deck where I talked to Edirin and Boska. I did not talk to either Chris or Leigh. Other than Chris was friendlier to me than he had in the past I did not notice anything unusual happen at the hospitality room. I had one glass of wine at the hospitality room.

We stayed at the hospitality room until the hosts were shutting it down. After that there was a group of us that decided to go to dinner. The group included myself, Edirin, Boska, Matt Hunter, Debbie Eco, John Juhl, Miko Tempski, Marc Bides, and Chris and Leigh. We ended up at the Stormy Mountain Brewing restaurant. Craig Matheson was there with someone else. He joined our group for dinner. Bob Hendrix also joined our group for dinner.

We sat at a big table. Chris and Leigh were at one end of the table. I was sitting across and at the other end of the table next to Edirin. See diagram attached. During dinner Chris tried to get my attention by calling out my name and saying "High 5." He also started throwing limes at me. I did not respond. I had 1 beer and about 1/8<sup>th</sup> of a second beer at the restaurant.

After dinner we decided to go back to Edirin's room in the Grandview Hotel. Miko, Marc, Mike Boska, and Bob Hendrix did not go. I went straight to the Grandview with Edirin, Craig, Chris and Leigh. When we got to the room Edirin offered drinks. Pretty soon I noticed that Craig and Edirin had left and I was alone with Chris and Leigh. This made me very uncomfortable because I had heard that Chris and Leigh had been looking for a 3<sup>rd</sup> partner before this evening. I ran out of the room into the parking lot, without stopping to pick up my purse.

When I got out into the parking lot I ran into Matt Hunter and Debbie Eco. They asked what I was doing in the parking lot. I told them I didn't want to be alone with Chris and Leigh. We all three went into Edirin's room then. Shortly after that Craig and Edirin came back. They may have been back in the room when I returned from the Parking Lot.

Eventually Hal Hupp, Jon Cummings, Kirk Mahjoubian, Nate Sugg, and John Juhl showed up. A bunch of people were smoking cigars on the deck. I don't like smoke so I decided to stay in the living room with Debbie Eco. I had one more glass of wine while at Edirin's. I don't think I finished that glass of wine before I was assaulted.

The deck was getting crowded and at one point Nate Sugg asked me to pull a large rectangular ottoman out onto the deck. I was pulling the ottoman out onto the deck and Nate was pushing from the other end. John Juhl was sitting in a chair next to the slider. Chris and Leigh were on a chair just to John's left. As I pulled the ottoman out onto the deck Chris reached out from behind me and grabbed

me. He had one hand on my breast and squeezed it while his other hand was around my mid-section. Chris tried to pull me onto his lap. I screamed and ran behind Matt Hunter who was standing at the railing on the deck. I then quickly went back inside the room.

After leaving the deck I decided to go back to my room. I had been wearing jeans and a crew neck shirt, but I decided to change my clothes because they were smelling smoky and I was uncomfortable. After changing my clothes I went back to Edirín's room and stayed in the living room with Debbie. I told Debbie that Chris had groped me. When Nate Sugg came in the living room from the deck I told him as well that Chris had groped me.

After a while Nate decided to go back onto the deck to smoke a cigar. He came right back in the room and alerted me to go look outside. I got up and looked out the slider. I saw Leigh was laying on Chris's lap like a rag doll. Both Chris and Leigh appeared heavily intoxicated. I could see that both of Leigh's breasts were completely exposed. I did not see Chris doing anything to Leigh at the time. I also noticed that John Juhl was sitting next to them, asleep.

When I saw what was going on I knocked on the window to get Edirín's attention. Edirín had his back to Leigh and Chris and was engaged in conversation with someone. Edirín looked at me and I pointed at Chris and Leigh. Edirín looked over at them and had a shocked look on his face. I sat back down on the couch in the living room. Nate and Edirín got Chris and Leigh to leave.

After Chris and Leigh left I talked some more about what Chris did to me. I told Craig about it and told him that Chris had groped me. Craig told me that what Chris did was not acceptable and that we can't have that kind of thing going on.

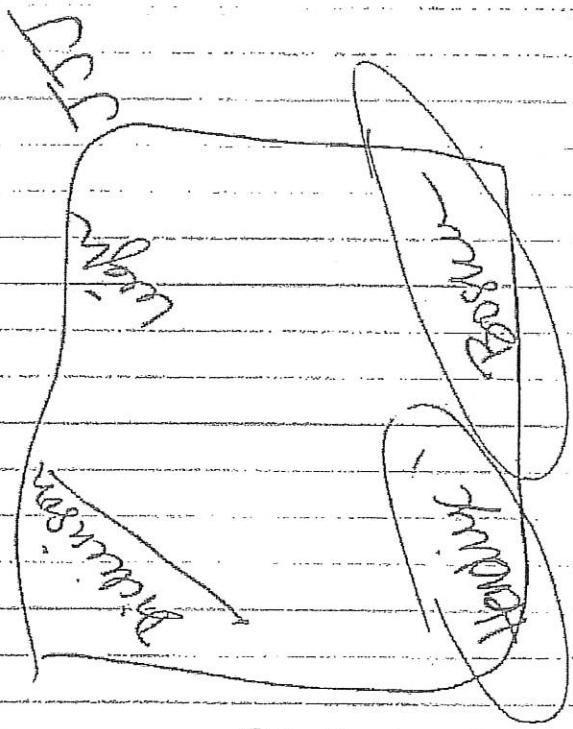
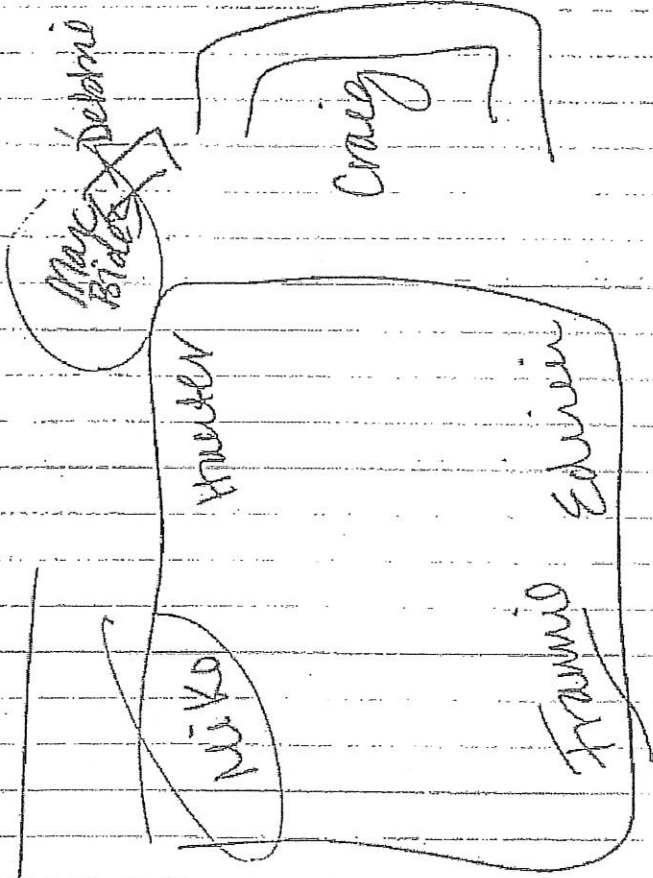
The next morning I was angry and wanted to tell Chris that what he did was not appropriate and that he was to never touch me again. I asked Edirín and Matt Hunter to be a witness to that when I talked to Chris. I never got the opportunity to do that on Thursday because Chris did not come to any of the classes.

On Thursday evening there was a bar-b-que at Campbell's that was organized by Adam Cornell. I went to the BBQ but I did not see Chris or Leigh there. Several people including Matt Hunter, Hal Hupp, and maybe Kirk Majoubian asked me how I was doing. I told them I was angry.


I was talking to Mike Boska about what happened while we were sitting on a dock near the lake. At first we didn't realize we were talking about two different things; I was talking about Chris groping me and Mike was talking about Leigh's breasts being exposed. When we realized we were talking about two different things I told Mike about Chris groping me. Bob Hendrix was nearby when we were having this discussion. Mike gestured to Bob and told Bob to come closer. Bob made a comment that he didn't want Frannie to accuse of him of grabbing her. That comment made me feel like I was the one that was causing problems and that people would not find me credible. Bob did come closer to Mike and me and we talked about the incident with Chris. During the course of the conversation Bob said something like, you're not going to get him fired, are you?

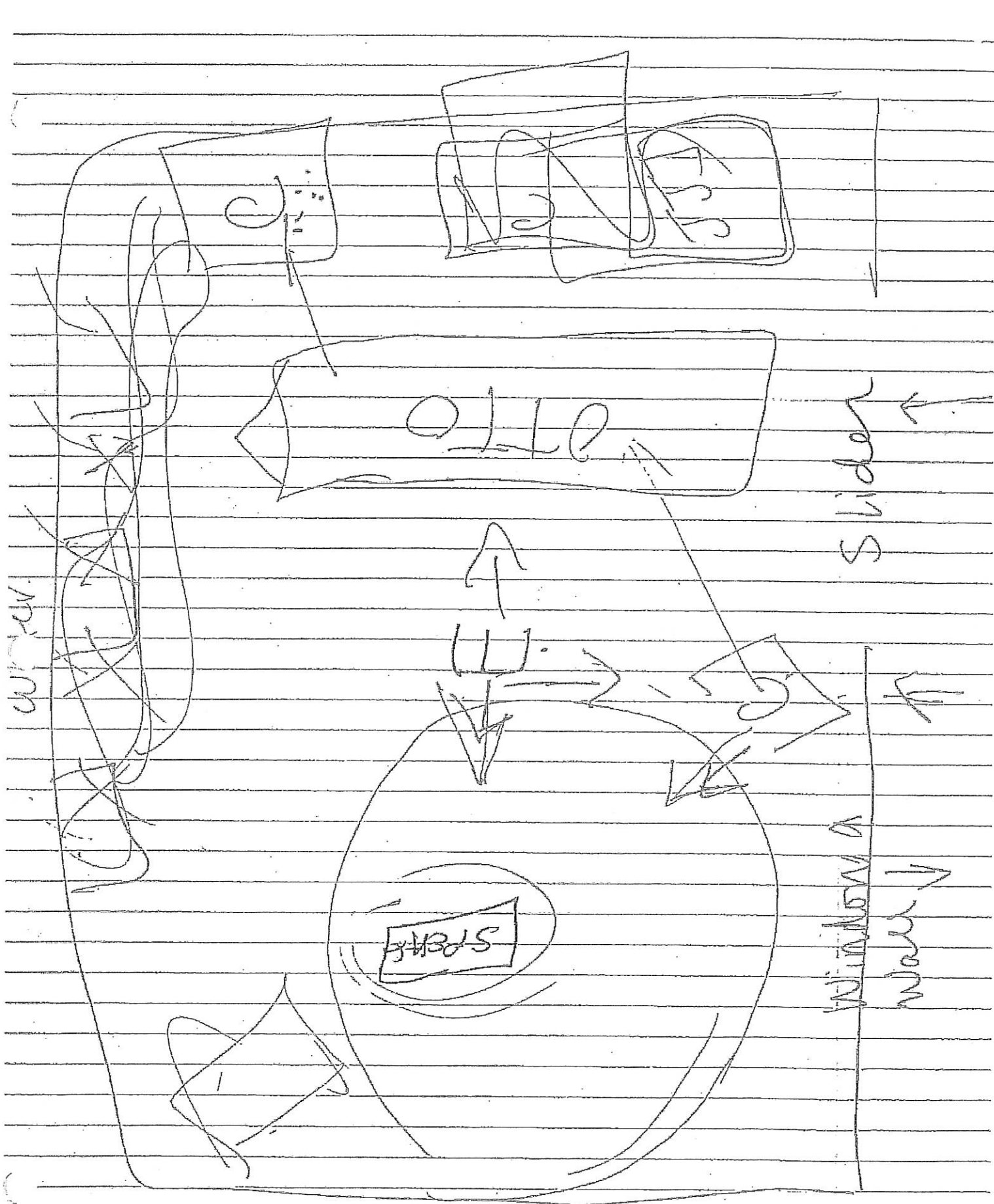

Statement of Debbie Eco

I went to Chelan with my boyfriend Matt Hunter on June 20-22, 2018. While he was in classes I hung out with a friend. On Wednesday June 20 I met Matt at the hospitality suite about 6 p.m. I drank two weak vodka/cranberry drinks. I did not drink any more alcohol for the rest of the evening as I had a headache. While at the hospitality suite I was introduced to and visited with Leigh Kellogg. She was drinking alcohol, but did not appear intoxicated. We stayed at the hospitality suite until it closed down.

From the hospitality room we walked to dinner with a group of people. The group included Matt and me, Miko, John Juhl, Edirin Okoloko, Frannie Yahyavi, Chris Dickenson and Leigh Kellogg. Our group had about 10 or 12 people in it. We went to one restaurant but were turned away by the management. I don't know why we were turned away. There was nothing about the behavior of anyone in our group that would have caused the management any concern about serving us.

We ended up at a second restaurant that was a brewery type restaurant. It was very casual dining where we had to order our dinner at the bar, and then someone brought it to us. We ran into Craig Matheson when we got there and he joined us for dinner. We were sitting at a larger table. It was large enough that the people at one end of the table could not talk to people at the other end of the table. Toward the end of the time we were at the restaurant Chris threw a rolled up napkin at me a couple of times. I took it as a flirtation, that he was trying to get my attention. I ignored it and he stopped.

After dinner Matt and I went to the Grandview to Edirin's room. When we got there we met Frannie in the parking lot. Frannie looked like she was feeling uncomfortable. She told us "they left me alone in there with them." She explained that Craig and Edirin had left to get ice and left her alone with Chris and Leigh. Matt, Frannie, and I then went to Edirin's room. I saw Chris and Leigh on the couch in the living room. Chris and Leigh were being very physically affectionate with each other, which made me feel very uncomfortable. I tried not to look at either of them much. Shortly after we arrived Craig and Edirin came back to the room.

Although I spent time on the deck, I spent most of the evening in the living room with Frannie because the deck was crowded and smoky. Frannie went out onto the deck a few times, but she mostly stayed in the living room too. Craig and Edirin went back and forth between the living room and the deck.

Sometime after we arrived at Edirin's, Jon Cummings, Nate Sugg, Kirk Majoubian, and John Juhl showed up. Those people were mostly hanging out on the deck. I was out on the deck standing at the rail near Matt when Frannie and Nate were pulling an ottoman out onto the deck from the living room. Chris was sitting in a chair against the wall dividing the deck to the room next door. John Juhl was sitting next to Chris. John was in the corner next to the sliding door and Chris was sitting closer to the railing. See diagram attached. As Frannie pulled the ottoman out of the room I saw Chris grab her around her breast area from behind and pull her toward his lap. Frannie immediately hopped over the ottoman and ran behind Matt. She exclaimed "oh my God! He just squeezed my boob!" I did not directly see Chris squeeze Frannie's breast but the way that he grabbed her around her chest area he could have done that. Frannie then went back into the living room.

I believe that Leigh was very drunk that night. On a scale of 1-10 with 10 being the most drunk she was a 15. Chris appeared to be drunk, as well. They had been drinking all night and continued to drink at Edirin's. I witnessed Chris continued to give Leigh alcoholic drinks after she was clearly intoxicated.

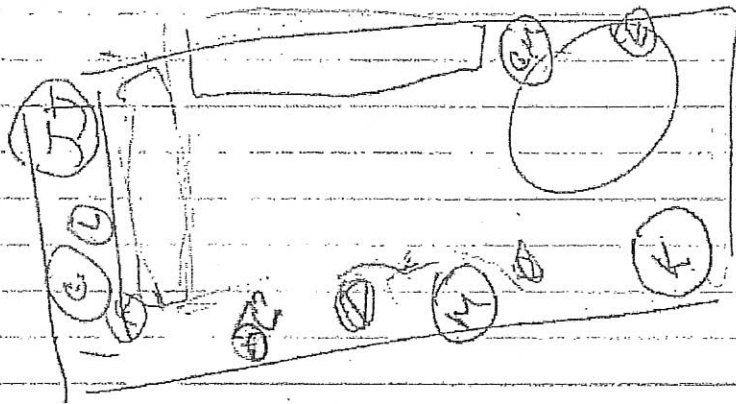


At one point Leigh started dancing in a very sexually provocative way. I believe it was more drunkenness than sexually motivated but it really made me uncomfortable, so I left the deck and went back into the living room.

At one point Nate Sugg was visiting with us in the living room for a while and he decided to go out to the deck to smoke a cigar. He made his way to the slider and then immediately turned around and said something like "boob alert!" I leaned out and saw Leigh laying on Chris's lap. She appeared to be passed out. I couldn't tell if Chris was passed out or not, but he was holding Leigh as she laid on his lap. Leigh's breasts were fully exposed. Leigh had been fussing with her shirt all night long. Everyone else on the deck seemed to be ignoring Chris and Leigh.

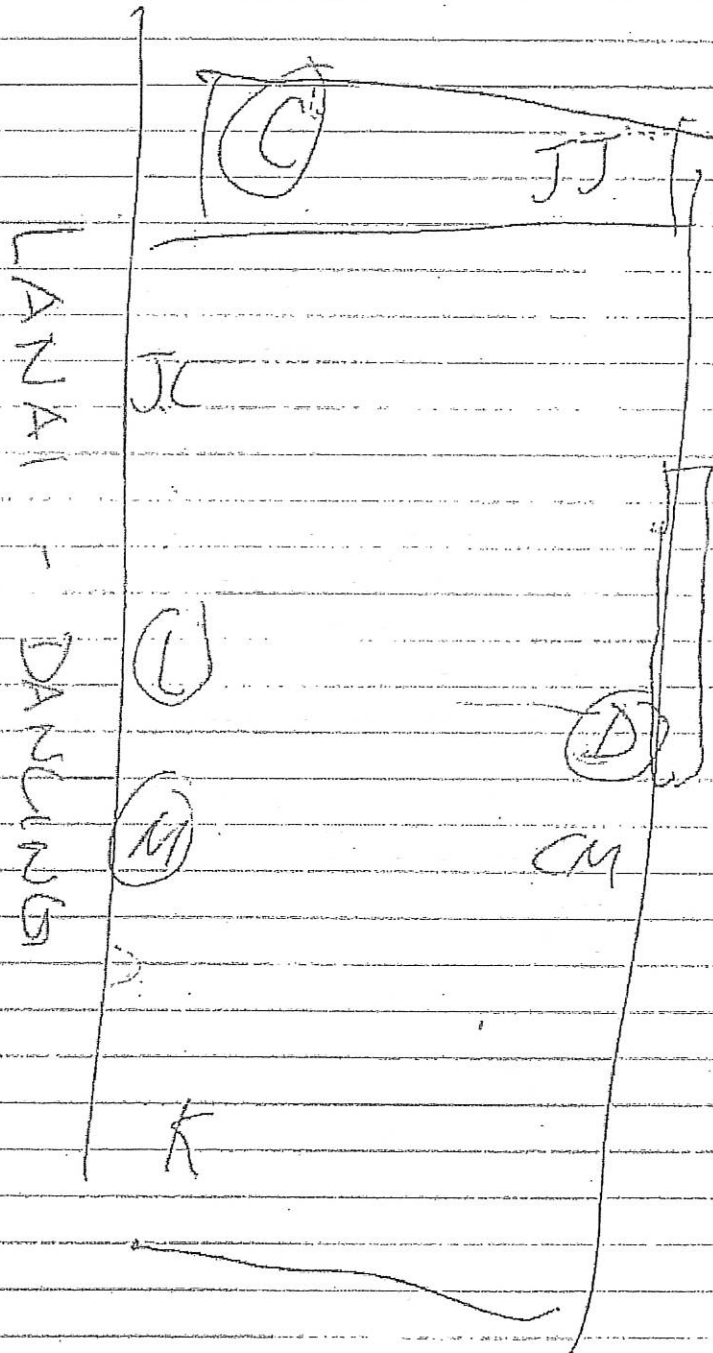

We left after that at approximately 1:00 a.m. I looked at the clock when we got back to the place we were staying. It was 1:28 a.m. It was about a 30 minute drive from the Grandview to where we were staying.

## Statement of Matt Hunter

I went to the Summer Conference in Cheban on June 20-22, 2018. My girlfriend Debbie Eco came with me but did not attend the classes. After class on Wednesday June 20 I went to the hospitality suite hosted by WAPA. Debbie met me there around 6-6:30 p.m. I had 2 whiskey drinks and 1 beer at the hospitality suite. We stayed until it was closing down.

From the hospitality suite Debbie, me, and a group of about 8-10 other people went looking for a place to have dinner. I recall the group included Edirin Okoloko, Frannie Yahyavi, Chris Dickenson and his girlfriend Leigh Kellogg, John Juhl, Miko Tempski and Marc Bides. There may have been others, I don't recall with any certainty. We first went to Tin Lilly's. The staff there ignored us and seemed unwilling to seat a party as large as ours. From there we went to a brewery restaurant where we had dinner. I had two beers at dinner. Nothing of note happened at dinner except that Chris threw a lemon peel at me as a joke. I threw it back and that was the end of it. I did not see Chris throwing anything at anyone else during the time we were at that restaurant.

After dinner we were invited to go to Edirin's hotel room for a drink and cigars. We all walked toward Edirin's hotel but Debbie and I split off to get some drinks to bring to the room. We were staying out of town with some friends, but had parked at Campbell's. When we got the drinks from my car we then walked across the bridge to the Grandview where Edirin was staying.

We arrived at the Grandview about 10 or 10:30 p.m. When we got there we met Frannie in the parking lot. We were looking at doors trying to figure out where Edirin's room was when we saw Frannie. She greeted us and then she walked with us to Edirin's room. Frannie explained to us that she was in the parking lot because she felt uncomfortable because Chris or Chris and Leigh were there.

Once we got into the room I saw that Chris and Leigh were already there. Chris was seated on the sofa in the living room. Leigh mixed one alcoholic drink for herself and one alcoholic drink for Chris. She served Chris his drink, and then came back and mixed a third alcoholic drink. I thought that was odd since neither had even started the first drinks that she had mixed. I felt that both Chris and Leigh were intoxicated already, but neither was falling down drunk at that point.

Debbie and Frannie stayed in the room while the rest of us went out onto the deck area. Eventually Nate Sugg, Kirk Majoubian, Jon Cummings, Hal Hupp (I think), and John Juhl showed up. At some point a large ottoman came out onto the deck, but I did not see how that happened. I had been facing away from where the ottoman was. I was trying to blow the smoke from my cigar out toward the lake so that it would not go in the room or bother others on the patio.

There was music playing while we were on the deck smoking and drinking. Leigh started dancing to the music. She got close to me but stayed at least 18" away from me and did not touch me. I learned after the fact that Leigh's dancing bothered Debbie a lot.

I did not see how this happened but at one point someone alerted me that something was going on where Leigh and Chris were sitting. I looked over and saw that she was laying against his chest with one breast exposed. Chris had his arm around the top part of her chest, holding her. Both Chris and Leigh seemed out of it. Leigh looked like she was asleep. I could not tell if Chris was asleep but he was not moving. John Juhl was sitting next to them and he definitely was asleep. It looked like Leigh and Chris

were cuddling. The whole situation made people uncomfortable. I was not paying that much attention to Chris or Leigh, but a little later I looked over and both of her breasts were exposed.

I do not know how Leigh's breasts were exposed; whether she did it, Chris did it, or it was just an accident. I do recall that she was fumbling with her top all night long and wondered if the exposure was an accident or had been done purposefully.

I do recall Kirk taking a photo of Jon Cummings and me. I was aware of it when he was taking it. I heard later that I was giving a thumbs-up gesture in the photo but didn't recall that. I can only surmise I was maybe mimicking Jon or responding to something Kirk said or asked. I was unaware of what Kirk's photo of me captured as I could not see his side of the camera/phone and wasn't shown the picture. I didn't think about Chris and Leigh's position behind me. It was not an effort to get a photo of them. We were just having fun and posed for a picture when prompted. My gesture was in no way connected to either or both of them (Chris/Leigh). In fact, like others, I was ignoring them. I suggested Kirk also take a picture of John Juhl who was still sleeping. I did not suggest that Kirk photograph Chris and Leigh. The next morning I heard someone mention that Kirk had a photo depicting Leigh's breast(s). I don't recall who I heard say that. When I saw Kirk I suggested he delete any such photo(s). This was before I talked to Hal and learned about Frannie. I wasn't suggesting Kirk destroy any form of evidence. I was suggesting it was inappropriate to have/show/forward such a photo. I learned Sunday night from Craig that I was in the same photo depicting Leigh's breasts.


Shortly after the photo of Jon and me was taken I threw the cigar into the lake and went back into the room. Debbie told me that she was uncomfortable with the way Leigh was acting and dancing. Debbie had been fighting a bad headache all night anyway so we decided to go. On the way home Debbie told me about an incident that night where Chris had grabbed Frannie and tried to pull her down on his lap. I was not looking in that direction and did not see that happen.

Before we left Chris, Leigh, and Edirin ended up outside the front door to the room. I don't know what Edirin was saying to Chris but I went out to see if Chris and Leigh were leaving and if so, how they planned to travel. I knew they came by boat. They confirmed that they were going to leave and go back to Leigh's (parent's?) home on the lake via the boat. I tried to get Chris and Leigh to call a cab because I thought they were too drunk to take their boat back home. Chris told me that he was "totally fine." I made a significant effort to talk them into using a taxi or Uber. All the while I was aware that I had interrupted whatever conversation Edirin was having with them so I excused myself and went back into Edirin's room to say goodbye and leave with Debbie. I don't know where Chris and Leigh were when Debbie and I did finally leave Edirin's room.

The next morning I saw Hal Hupp during a break. Hal told me that Frannie was really upset about what Chris had done to her. I learned for the first time from Hal that Chris grabbed Frannie's breast(s). Prior to this, I erroneously assumed from what Debbie told me that he had grabbed her hips(s) or shoulder(s). Later that morning Edirin also told me what had happened to Frannie. This was the first time that I heard that Chris had grabbed her breast.

On Thursday evening Debbie and I had dinner with friends, but later in the evening we went to Campbells where there had been a Bar-b-Que. We wanted to see if there was anyone still there. We got there around 10 p.m. and there were still people there. I talked to Adam Cornell about what happened. I also talked to Frannie. I expressed concern for her. Debbie and I left around 10:30 p.m.

Chris was not in class all Thursday. When I saw Chris and Leigh in class on Friday morning I asked them, "How are you guys?" They both answered: "Good" and were acting normal. I decided I needed to talk to Craig Matheson about what had happened as a result of the sexual harassment training that we had been given. I saw Craig at a social event on Sunday and talked to him about it. At that time I learned that Craig had already taken action by talking to Marie Gallagher.

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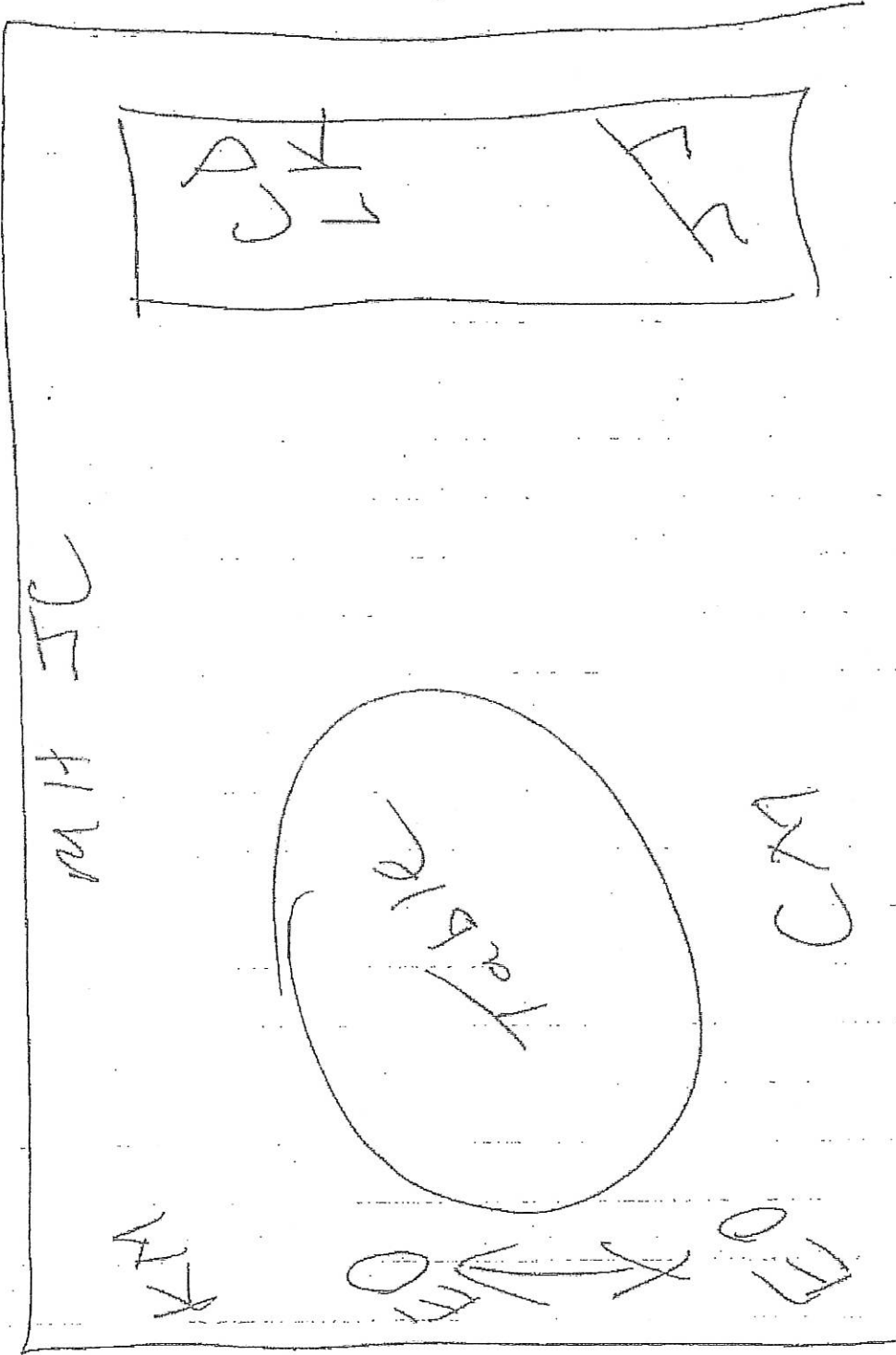

### STATEMENT OF EDIRIN OKOLOKO

I attended the WAPA summer conference in Chelan, WA the week of June 20-22, 2018. After class on June 20, I went to the hospitality suite at Campbell's resort with Francesca Yahyavi. The hospitality event was already underway for some time before we arrived. There were several attorneys from the office and other jurisdictions at the suite when we arrived. After getting a drink, we started chatting with Adam Sturdivant and his wife. Chris Dickenson walked by and said hello. He then invited us out to the balcony and walked off. A little while later, I walked out on to the Balcony, leaving Francesca still chatting with Sturdivant and his wife in the living room of the Suite. On the balcony, I spoke with Laura Harmon, Kirk Majoubian, Nathan Sugg, Mike Boska, Jon Cummings, Bob Hendrix, Matt Hunter and his girlfriend Debbie Eco, John Juhl, Miko Tempski, Marc Bides, Chris Dickenson and a female he introduced as his girlfriend Leigh.

I was at the hospitality suite for less than an hour before it started shutting down. There were several suggestions made by DPAs from the office for a location for dinner. Some DPA's suggested a Mexican Restaurant and left for what I presumed was that location. A group of us decided to walk down to the main street to find a place for dinner. This group included myself, Matt Hunter, Debbie Eco, Francesca Yahyavi, Mike Boska, Miko Tempski, Marc Bides, John Juhl, Chris Dickenson, and his girlfriend Leigh. We first went to a restaurant called the Tin Lilly but they could not accommodate the size of our group. We then walked back to another restaurant where we met up with Craig Matheson who was already there. Our group sat down to have dinner. There were some other younger DPA's at a different table.

After dinner, I invited Craig Matheson, Matt Hunter Francesca, and Debbie back to my room for some cigars and whiskey. I was staying in a one bedroom condo at the Grandview Hotel, which is across the lake from Campbell. The Condo has a bedroom, a separate living room, and a balcony off the living room with an up lake view. We left the restaurant and walked back to the hotel. Francesca split off on the way back and walked Miko and Marc back to their car which was parked on the other side of the street. Francesca then rejoined Craig, myself, Hunter, and Debbie as we walked back to my hotel. Chris and his girlfriend followed us back to my room.

When we got to my room, Craig and I left to get some ice from the ice machine outside the hotel; we returned a couple of minutes later. Hunter, Debbie, and Francesca showed up a couple of minutes later. We got some cigars and went out on the balcony to smoke cigars, sip whiskey, and listen to music. It was still light out when we returned to the room. Chris and Leigh came out on the balcony as well and sat in a chair on the balcony.

Later, John Juhl, Kirk Majoubian, John Cummings, and Nate Sugg showed up at my room. Juhl sat in a chair next to Chris and Leigh on the balcony. Everything seemed fine. I was chatting with Craig and Hunter and others were engaged in conversations as well. It was dark out at this point and the balcony light was off. The light source was from the light in the living room. Hal Hupp texted me asking where I was. I texted him back telling him I was in my room with Craig and invited him over. At some point in the night I recall briefly seeing Leigh dancing next to Chris. I had my back to them so did not really see what was going on. For most of the night, I was playing the music on the balcony so a lot of my focus was on my phone selecting the different songs that I was streaming to my blue tooth speaker. Kirk Majoubian later took over the music selection. Hal showed up and joined us on the deck. I got a cigar for him.

Francesca spent most of the evening in the living room talking with Debbie. At some point that night, I recall briefly seeing Francesca carrying an Ottoman out on the balcony with Nathan Sugg. I did not see anything happen to Francesca when she carried out the ottoman on the deck but then again, I was not


focused on her and Nate. I do recall not seeing Francesca in the room for some time after the ottoman incident.

For most of the evening, I was on the opposite side of the balcony from where Chris and Leigh were sitting. My impression was that Chris and Leigh were pretty buzzed, but I do not know Leigh and don't know what her tolerance is like. I do recall seeing Leigh sitting on Chris's lap and cuddling with him. I did not think anything of it because it appeared that the physical touching was consensual. Most of the evening, I was sitting facing the lake with them out of view to my right. There were times when I had my back to them standing against the railing facing the opposite wall. On one of such occasions, when I had my back to them, I heard a pounding sound on the glass window to my left. I looked over and saw Francesca trying to get my attention from inside the living room. Francesca pointed behind me in the direction where Chris, Leigh, and John Juhl, were sitting. I turned around and saw Leigh still sitting on Chris's lap. Her eyes were closed but I could not tell if she was asleep or unconscious. Chris looked like he was nodding off too, but I couldn't tell if he was unconscious or not. Leigh's breasts were exposed. I did not see how her breasts got exposed. I went over to Chris and tapped him. I told him that was not acceptable and that this was bothersome to people. I told him that Leigh needed to cover up. I asked them to follow me out of my room. Nate Sugg also assisted in getting them out of the room. Matt Hunter also came out to the hallway to see if they were going to be ok getting home. I told Chris that I was ok with them hanging out earlier but this behavior was bothersome.

I went back into my room and Chris and Leigh left. Francesca later told me that she was really angry with Chris because he had grabbed her from behind when she was helping Nate carry the ottoman onto the balcony. Francesca said that was why she left my room earlier and returned to her room to process what had happened.

The rest of the evening proceeded normally. After cigars and some more conversation and music, every one cleared out and went back to their rooms. Some DPA's were also staying at the Grandview.

I did not know until the next morning that Chris had grabbed Francesca's breast. Francesca told me the next morning and explained that she hardly slept when she returned to her room the previous night. Francesca was very upset as she spoke to me and was teary eyed. She remained withdrawn and in a contemplative mood for the rest of the day. She told me she wanted to confront Chris about the incident. She took a walk to be by herself for a while.

Statement of Hal Hupp

I went to the WAPA conference on June 20-22, 2018. I brought my family who vacationed there while I was in class. On Wednesday after class I went to the hospitality room with my wife and two kids. I drank a whisky that I refilled to equal about 1-1/2 drinks. I estimate that I drank about 3-4 oz of whisky while at the hospitality room. I may have had one beer at dinner but I don't recall. Other than that I did not drink alcohol that evening.

After leaving the hospitality suite I went back to our rooms where I spent the evening with my family. We ordered in a pizza and watched movies until my wife and kids went to bed around 10-10:30.

I had received a text from Edirin Okoloko asking me to come over to his hotel room. About the time my family went to bed I went over there. When I got to Edirin's room I saw Frannie Yahyavi in the living room. I looked out onto the deck and saw Leigh Kellogg doing a sexy dance on the deck. I was not happy to see her and Chris at the gathering. I took over Chris's case load when he was transferred out of juvenile back downtown as a result of the fall-out from his relationship with Leigh. When I picked up his case load I had about two months of messes to clean up.

I have gone to the summer WAPA conference for years and have gone to Edirin's gatherings at his hotel room after dinner on many occasions. This is the first time I have ever seen Chris or his girlfriend at Edirin's get together.

I talked to Frannie and Debbie in the living room for a few minutes. Edirin then came in and offered me a cigar and a scotch. I went out onto the deck to get a cigar and a drink. My back was to where Chris was sitting. I was facing Matt Hunter and Kirk Mahjoubian. I saw people looking at something behind me so I turned and looked. I saw Chris with Leigh on his lap. Chris's arms were around Leigh. It looked like they were cuddling. I noticed that one of Leigh's breasts were exposed. Because of what I had been told about their relationship I thought that Chris and Leigh thought it was amusing for her to expose herself like that. I wasn't particularly shocked by their behavior, but it was uncomfortable.

There was music playing when I got out onto the deck. After a couple of songs had played I heard Frannie banging on the window. Nate Sugg then came out on the deck and said everyone who is sleeping has to leave. Chris and Leigh stood up and at that point I noticed that both of her breasts were exposed. I could tell by Chris's body language that he was not happy about trying to get Nate to leave.

I was not aware tht pictures were taken when they were taken. I saw Krik looking at photos on the patio and he showed me a picture of me walking onto the deck. I was unaware that he had taken that photo until he showed me.

After Chris, Leigh, and some others left I talked to Frannie. She told me that Chris had grabbed her. She demonstrated by gesturing with her hand that he had grabbed her breast. She told me that Chris was trying to pull her onto his lap.

## Statement of Craig Matheson

I attended the WAPA training in Chelan on June 20-22, 2018. On Wednesday June 20 I had dinner after class with a group of people that included Edirin Okoloko, Frannie Yahyavi, Chris Dickinson, Leigh Kellogg and some other people. After dinner I went to Edirin Okoloko's hotel room at Edirin's invitation. We planned on smoking cigars, sipping whiskey, and just talking. Before going to Edirin's I had drank 3 beers and 2 glasses of wine. While at Edirin's I drank 3-4 whiskey drinks. I had drank enough that I would not drive, but I do have a good memory of what happened that night.

We got there about 9-9:30 p.m. At first the only people there were Edirin, Frannie Yahyavi, Chris Dickenson, Leigh Kellogg, and myself. At some point, maybe 30 minutes later, Matt Hunter and Debbie Eco arrived. Edirin and I left for a few minutes to go get some ice. When I got back Frannie was upset and asked me "why did you leave me with that creep." Either right after that or a little later Frannie then said that Chris had groped her. A few minutes later I asked her to clarify what she meant. Frannie then gestured with her hand indicating that he had groped her breast. My impression from what she said was that Chris had groped Frannie when we were gone getting ice. At that point I knew that I was going to need to get some advice about how to proceed from Marie Gallagher since I did not know if this qualified as a work event or not.

After Edirin and I got back from getting ice and Matt Hunter and Debbie Eco arrived some of us went out onto the deck. There were five or six of us that were out on the deck. Chris and Leigh were two of the people on the deck. It was about 85 degrees out. Frannie stayed inside the hotel room most of the night.

It was clear that Chris and Leigh were very intoxicated. At one point Leigh dropped a glass and broke it.

At another point while we were sitting on the deck I was in a chair by the slider facing the railing. Kurt Majoubian was sitting in the corner. Matt Hunter was standing by the railing and Edirin was standing next to Matt on his left. Chris was sitting on the other side of the deck. There was music playing through a speaker from someone's phone. Leigh stand up and starts dancing next to Matt Hunter. It looked like she was grinding on him. Chris was just sitting there watching her dancing next to Hunter. I was not surprised to see her dancing provocatively because I had heard rumors from others that Chris and Leigh were looking for a third partner. I did not hear that directly from Chris or Leigh though.


After the music stopped and Leigh stopped dancing she went over and sat on Chris's lap. She started grinding he butt into his groin area, and Chris allows her to do that. I also glanced over and saw that Chris was fondling Leigh's breasts and they may have been kissing. I saw them behave this way once before at a holiday party last December. I did not want to look at it so I turned away. I did not turn back to look at them again until someone alerted me about something going on with them. I looked over and saw Leigh's breasts were exposed. Her shirt was pulled down and her bra was pulled up. She was passed out when that happened.

I heard a click and then knew that Kirk had taken a photo of Chris and Leigh. I did not know beforehand that he intended to photograph them. I did not know that Leigh was passed out when Kirk took the picture, but I certainly knew that later however. I thought that he had only taken one photo. I instructed him to forward the photo to me. I did not direct him to delete the photo. I learned the following Monday that Kirk had taken two photos showing Chris and Leigh with her breasts showing.

Eventually Chris and Leigh left the hotel room. I did not see the circumstances of how that happened.

I did not see Chris at any of the other classes over the next two days. On the way home on Friday afternoon I called Marie Galagher for advice on [REDACTED]

### Statement of Leigh Kellogg

I went to Chelan on June 20-22, 2018 with my boyfriend Chris Dickenson when he attended the prosecutor's training held there. After classes ended on Wednesday June 20 we went to the hospitality suite. I had three drinks while at the suite. From there a group of us went to the Stormy Mountain Brewery for dinner. Chris and I each had a beer at the restaurant. I don't recall if I finished my beer or not.

After dinner Chris and I went with others from his office to Edirin Okoloko's hotel room. At the beginning we were sitting on a sofa in the living room. Chris was pointing out to me who was who from his office that were at that gathering. We then went out onto the deck where Chris and I were talking to Matt Hunter, his girlfriend, and John Juhl. There were at least 6 people on the deck when we were out there. We spent most of our time on the deck when we were at Edirin's room.

While people were on the deck there were some people drinking. I don't recall drinking any alcohol after I got to Edirin's. I thought Chris was drinking water. At one point in the evening I bumped Chris's arm causing him to drop the glass he was holding and it broke and went over the side of the railing.

While Chris and I were sitting on the deck we sat in a corner between the slider and the railing, against the wall that separated Edirin's unit from the unit next door. We stayed in that area the whole time we were there. We did not get up to socialize with anyone, but some people on the deck came up and talked to us.

I don't recall there being any music playing while on the deck. I don't remember dancing while we were on the deck. I do remember that it was getting on toward 11 p.m. and the people on the deck were being noisy. I thought it might be too noisy for other hotel guests.

I often sit on Chris's lap, especially when there is limited seating or so that I can talk to him more easily and hear what he is saying. I recall sitting on Chris's lap while we were sitting on the deck.

I wore a sundress that evening that tied around the back of my neck and had openings on the shoulders in the sleeves. The sundress had a snap in the front that had never been a problem before but that evening for some reason it was loose and kept unsnapping. I had tried to find a safety pin to secure the front of my dress but could not find one. Instead I wore a band style bathing suit top. The top was a little loose and when I jump in the water wearing it I have to adjust it. I was not aware that my breasts were exposed at any time that night in Edirin's room or on the deck. I understand that they were exposed. The only explanation I can give is that it was an accident. The loose bathing suit top must have re-adjusted itself and I was not aware of that. The combination of the re-adjusted bathing suit top and the snap that kept coming undone must have caused my breasts to be exposed.

I don't recall anyone taking a picture of me and Chris on the deck. I did not know that someone had taken a picture of me when my breasts were exposed. I do not recall ever falling asleep or passing out while at Edirin's. I do remember that I was tired, and was tired before going to Edirin's. I wondered if we should have just gone back to our place rather than going to Edirin's. I also remember leaning up against Chris because I was tired.

I don't recall the circumstances of us leaving. I think it was shortly after the glass got broken.

I am aware that Chris has a picture of me on his screensaver on his cell phone. The picture shows me unclothed from the waist down. I was not aware that Chris was showing that picture of me to his co-workers. I am not okay with him doing that and would not have given him permission to do that.

Statement of Bob Hendrix

I went to the CLE put on by WAPA on June 20-22, 2018. After classes on June 20 I went to the hospitality suite. I was there with Matt Hunter, Debbie Eco, Chris Dickinson, Leigh Kellogg, and Mike Boska. While there I also socialized with Hal Hupp and his family and DPAs from several different counties.

After leaving the hospitality suite we went to The Tin Lilly in a group. There were several unoccupied tables in a closed section of the patio, but the host stated that they could not seat a group as large as ours (there were approximately 11 people in our group) and that the closed section of the patio was only open on the 4<sup>th</sup> of July. Edirin Okoloko and I tried to talk the host into letting us in and Edirin also tried to convince the manager of the restaurant, but we both gave up when it became clear that we were not going to be seated as a group.

We then went to a BBQ restaurant where I had dinner with Frannie Yahyavi, Mike Boska, Chris Dickinson, Leigh Kellogg, Craig Matheson, Matt Hunter, Debbie Eco, and Mike Boska. I believe that a few other people were at the table, but cannot state this with certainty. I primarily spoke with Chris, Mike, and Frannie, but also had conversations with Debbie and Craig. I was not feeling my best and left right after eating. I walked back to my room where I remained for the rest of the night. I do not recall anything unusual happening at dinner. However, I did leave before everyone else.

The next day I heard about Frannie being grabbed the previous night. The first person who told me this was Hal Hupp. He told me Thursday morning right before classes started. Hal also told me that people had a lot to drink, that Chris and Leigh were being amorous in a room filled with DPAs, that Leigh's breasts got exposed and that she passed out. This was when he told me that Chris had grabbed Frannie's breast.

Thursday evening I went to a Bar-be-Que at Campbell's. While there I saw Frannie. I believe she was sitting by herself and I asked her if she was ok. She said yes and told me what happened. I did not say anything to make light of the unwelcome touching. However, it was uncomfortable as I like and respect everyone involved. I did ask Frannie if the contact was welcome, I didn't know how serious the situation was and whether it was casual or an assault. Frannie assured me that the contact was not welcomed.

I do recall joking with someone, maybe Nate Sugg, that Chris might be at the bottom of the lake since had had obviously been very intoxicated the prior night, the boat he had moored was gone, and no one had seen him. I also recall discussing theoretical criminal charges that could possibly apply as well as defenses. I do not recall specifically who I had this discussion with, but it was on Thursday evening.

I did not tell Frannie about any repercussions that Chris might face for his conduct with her. My intent was to let her know that I supported her and for her and everyone to have a nice time at this social gathering on the shores of the lake. I also did not talk about any specific disciplinary action since I assumed that this would not result in any disciplinary action. I did say several times to several people that this was not good (referring to the grabbing of Frannie) and which perhaps had the potential to create the appearance that I was referencing repercussions.

On Friday morning, July 22<sup>nd</sup>, I saw Chris in the conference room before class. I talked to him about what Frannie told me, telling him that I understood that there had been an incident between him and Frannie the other night. Chris asked me what I was talking about. He appeared to have no memory of what I was referring to. I followed up by telling him that Frannie was not ok with it, intending to let him know that there might be an issue with what did happen.

Statement of John Juhl

I went to the WAPA training in Chelan on June 20-22, 2018. On Wednesday I got up at 4:00 a.m. and went to Leavenworth where I played 18 holes of golf starting around 7:30 a.m. before going on to Chelan. I went to class in the afternoon and afterwards went to the hospitality room. There I drank a gin and tonic and two glasses of red wine. I stayed at the hospitality room until it closed down.

After the hospitality room closed down I went to dinner with a group of people at Stormy Mountain Brewery. Craig Matheson, Chris Dickenson, Leigh Kellogg, and Bob Hendrix were some of the people I remember having dinner with. I had a couple of beers with dinner. After dinner I may have gone to Tin Lillys or I may have gone straight to Edirin's room at the Grandview. I can't recall which place I went to first, but I do remember going to Edirin's hotel room with Nate Sugg, and Kurt Majoubian.

By the time I got to Edirin's I was feeling the alcohol I had drank, and the long day of golf, driving and class. I remember that Edirin, Nate, Kirk were at the room. Chris and Leigh were on the deck. I don't recall if Matt Hunter was there or not. I do know that Frannie Yahyavi was there but I can't remember if she was in the room or on the deck. I did get one more shot of scotch and sat on the deck. I don't remember anything after that until Nate woke me up and sent me back to my hotel room. At that point I returned to my room.

On June 21 I didn't see Chris at any of the classes during the day. In the evening I went to a bar-b-que at Campbell's. I got there about 6:30- 7:00 p.m. I did not see Chris or Leigh at the BBQ that night. I was talking to some of my co-workers about where Chris was because no one had seen them. I heard that Frannie was mad at Chris but I did not hear why she was mad at him.

## Statement of Nate Sugg

After the class on Wednesday June 20, 2018 I went to the hospitality room with Jon Cummings, Kirk Majoubian and his wife [REDACTED] Ryan Anderson from the King County Prosecutor's Office, Adam Sturdivant and his wife [REDACTED] and Laura Harmon. I saw Chris Dickenson and his girlfriend Leigh at the hospitality room, but only talked to him briefly about the case that we are co-chairing. I had two beers at the hospitality room and then went to dinner with about 12 people at a Mexican restaurant.

After eating dinner at the Mexican restaurant I went to Tin Lilly's with Kirk Majoubian and Jon Cummings. We met John Juhl there and had some more beers at that bar. From there we went to Edirin Okoloko's room at the Grandview. We got there around 11-11:30 p.m. I had drunk about 7 beers by the time I got to Edirin's room which was a 4-5 hour period of time. I did not drink anything after leaving Tin Lilly's. I feel like my memory of what happened is good, despite drinking that much. I would not have driven, but I remember the events described.

When we got there Craig Matheson, Matt Hunter, Matt's girlfriend Debbie, Frannie Yahyavi, Edirin, Chris Dickinson and Chris's girlfriend Leigh were there. We went out on the deck where people were smoking cigars and drinking scotch. Frannie and Debbie stayed inside and were not on the deck.

I stayed on the deck for about 10 minutes before going back inside the room. At some point while I was out there I saw Leigh dancing very close to Matt Hunter. She was not touching Matt, but Leigh was close enough to Matt to make his girlfriend Debbie uncomfortable.

There was not enough seating out on the deck so I wanted to pull a large ottoman out there for people to sit on. I asked Frannie to help me move the ottoman out the door onto the deck. Frannie was walking backwards out of the room pulling the ottoman onto the deck. There were two chairs to our right as we were pulling the ottoman out onto the deck. The first chair was occupied by John Juhl. Chris Dickinson was sitting in the second chair. Everyone else on the deck was gathered around a table on the other side of the deck. When we got the ottoman out onto the deck John immediately put his feet up on it before we could get it rotated so people could sit on it. Chris sat back down in his chair and then put his feet up too. I assume he got up to get out of the way when the ottoman arrived. I was really frustrated with John and Chris for doing that so I just walked back inside.

When I went inside Frannie followed me. She told me that Chris had groped her and then gestured with her hand demonstrating that he had grabbed her breast. I continued to talk to Frannie and Debbie in the room about it for a while. I then went outside to talk to Edirin for a bit.

When I got outside Edirin offered me a cigar. I came inside the room to cut the cigar and talked to Frannie and Debbie some more. I then decided that I wanted to go outside to smoke the cigar. I got to the slider and looked out. When I looked out I saw Leigh sitting on Chris's lap with her breasts exposed. Her bra was pulled up and her top was pulled down. Leigh looked like she was passed out. I didn't see Chris touching Leigh's breasts at that point, but his arms were around her. I did think that both Leigh and Chris were very drunk.

I turned around and alerted Frannie to what was going on telling her that Leigh's tits were out. Frannie got up and looked out the window. She then knocked on the window to get Edirin's attention.



I also saw that John Juhl had fallen asleep. I decided that the best way to end the situation was to tell everyone who was sleeping to go home. I went out onto the deck, woke John up, and told him that he had to leave. I then told Chris that if Leigh was sleeping then they had to go too. I walked John Juhl out of the room into the parking lot to make sure he could get home safe. When I got back Edirin was talking to Chris just outside of the front door to the room. Chris was explaining to Edirin that Leigh was ok with "that" which I took to mean exposing her breasts in public. Edirin told Chris that others were not ok with her doing that.

After Chris and Leigh left we all were talking about how weird that situation was. Kirk said he had taken a photo. Craig asked Kirk to send the photo to him. Craig did not instruct Kirk to delete the photo or to refrain from showing it to anyone else.

I went to a bar-b-que on Thursday night at Campbell's. Chris was not there. I talked to Frannie about what happened to her the night before with Chris. She said she was still processing what happened, and it still bothered her.

### Statement of Jon Cummings

I went to the hospitality room with Sugg, Kirk, Kirk's wife, Laura Harmon, a KCDPA. The party was already going when we got there. I had two beers while at the hospitality room. We stayed about an hour. Went to the main street and ended up eating dinner at a Mexican restaurant. While waiting for a table a couple of us went to Stormy Mountain Brewing restaurant where I had another beer.

While at Stormy Mountain I talked to Craig. Adam Sturdivant was with me talking to Craig. Adam's wife and other women from our group stayed outside. We didn't eat dinner with Craig and his group. Instead we ate at the Mexican restaurant. I didn't drink anything at the Mexican restaurant.

After dinner we went to Tin Lilly restaurant bar and had another beer. It dusk approaching dark when we were at Tin Lilly. We were there for 30-45 minutes. I was at Tin Lilly with Nate and Kirk. Found another group of DPAs at Tin Lilly, mostly not from Snohomish County. John Juhl joined us at Tin Lilly.

We had previously been invited by Edirin to go hang out with him at his room. After Tin Lilly I went to Edirin's with John Juhl, Kirk, and Nate. I'm not sure how late it was when we got to Edirin's but it was dark out when we got there.

When we got to Edirin's there was several people on the deck smoking cigars. I had one more beer at Edirin's. I got the beer from my room before going to Edirin's. My room was in the same building that Edirin's room was in. People were sipping whiskey out on the deck. There were a couple people inside. Matt Hunter's girlfriend was inside most of the time, Francesca Yahyavi was inside too. I spent most of my time on the deck, usually standing by the railing.

We were on the deck for quite awhile drinking, smoking, listening to music, and having a good time. Chris's girlfriend was up and around for awhile, dancing around. John Juhl was sitting in the chair in the corner. Chris and his girlfriend were on a 2 person chair next to John. I was mostly facing toward the people that were in the corner away from where Chris, his girlfriend and John Juhl were sitting. I did notice at one point that Chris's girlfriend's breasts were exposed. I did not see how Chris's girlfriend's shirt came up but I looked over and saw that it was up. She was clearly intoxicated. She looked like she was passed out from alcohol when her breasts were exposed. I had little interaction with Chris. I didn't know whether Chris was passed out, too, but saw his hands around her belly area. It looked like he was holding her up. I tried not to look at her because it was awkward. John Juhl also appeared to be asleep while sitting in a chair near Chris and his girlfriend.

I don't know whose idea it was but Kirk took about 2-3 pictures of the area where Chris and his girlfriend and John Juhl were. I don't know why the picture was taken except it was a weird moment of adults not being able to handle their alcohol. When I realized there was a picture being taken I put my arm around Matt and we posed for a second picture. I may have had a thumbs up when we posed for that picture Kirk took. Shortly after that Nate asked them to leave.

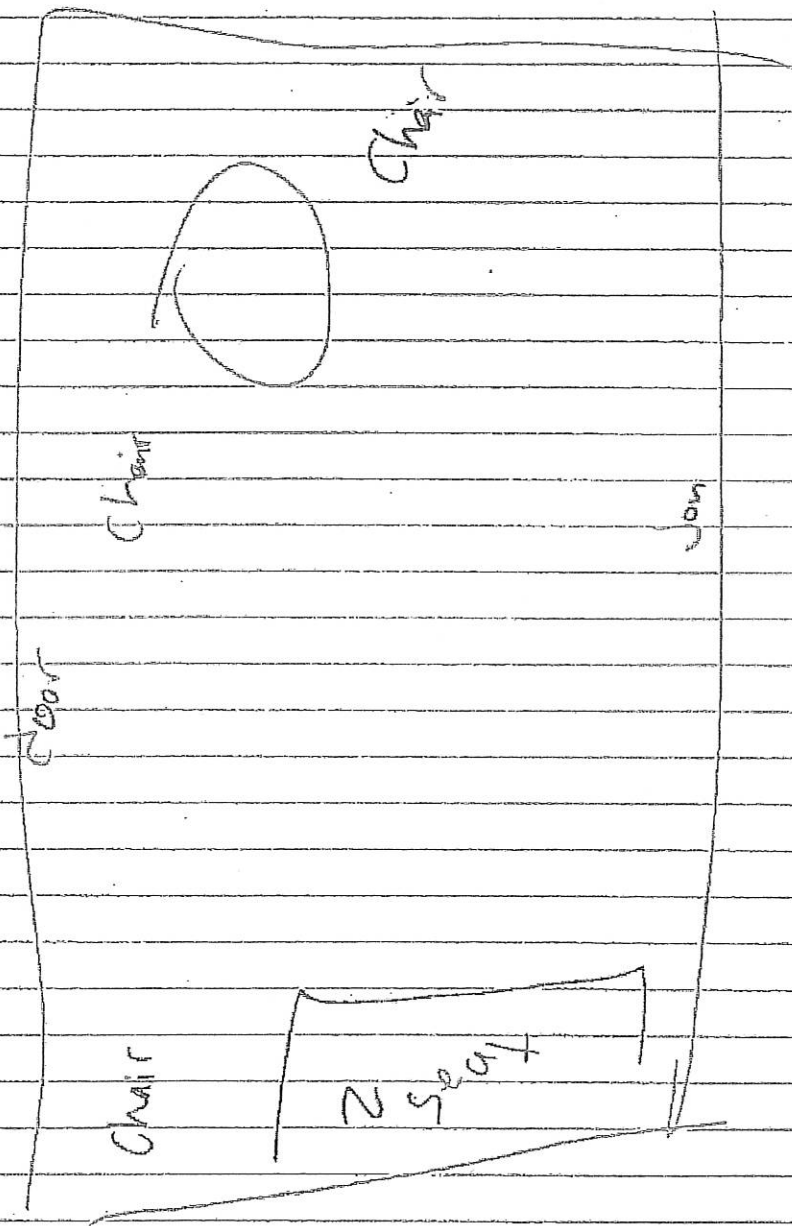
Chris's girlfriend's breasts were exposed for about 5 minutes when Nate Sugg told John Juhl and Chris and his girlfriend that it was time to go. Edirin also helped them out at some point. That was the last time I saw Chris or his girlfriend that evening. I turned away when they were being escorted out.

It is possible that Frannie was out on the deck but I don't have a good recollection of how long or when she was on the deck. I didn't notice or I don't have a recollection of Frannie interacting with anyone on the deck. I don't recall seeing anyone touching Frannie when she was on the deck.

We stayed for awhile at Edirin's after several other people left. Nate and Edirin and I talked about office stuff. We left probably around 1:00 a.m. Kirk, Nate, and I left about the same time. There were not many people left by the time that we had left.

## Statement of Kirk Mahjoubian

I attended the WAPA conference in Chelan on June 20-22, 2018. On Wednesday June 20 after classes ended I went to the hospitality room with my wife and another King County DPA. We arrived about mid-way through the event. I drank 2 beers at the hospitality room. We left after about one hour to go to dinner.

I went with a group of people to eat at a Mexican restaurant. We ran into Craig Matheson. Either Craig or someone else invited over to Edirin Okoloko's room after dinner. I went to Edirin's room with Nate Sugg and Jon Cummings. By the time I got there I had drunk 6-8 beers over the course of about 5 hours. Matt Hunter, Craig Matheson, Edirin, Frannie Yahyavi, John Juhl, Chris Dickenson and Leigh Kellogg were there. I don't recall where everyone was during the time that I was there, but I spent most of the time I was there on the deck. We were talking, listening to music, smoking cigars, and drinking scotch. I felt drunk to the point that I would not drive while I was sitting on the deck. I was not blackout drunk or falling down drunk. I did not have a hangover the next morning.

When I first came out onto the deck Chris Dickenson was sitting there. I was wearing some colorful shorts. Dickenson said to me "nice shorts fuckin' faggot." I said "what?" Chris repeated "nice shorts fuckin' faggot." Chris was really drunk so that why I think he said that. His comment made me uncomfortable because I am a newer DPA who is at the beginning of my career here and Chris is a senior DPA. I did not want to say anything to anyone more senior than me that could hurt my career here so I was careful and so I just said something like Hey I like these shorts and let it drop.

I recall seeing Frannie on the deck - it seemed like she went between the deck and the living room. I did not see any interaction between Frannie and Chris on the deck.


About midnight I saw Leigh sitting on Chris's lap. I did not see how it happened but her breasts were exposed. I can't remember how long they were exposed. I saw that Leigh was unconscious for part of the time that her breasts were exposed. Chris was conscious when this happened. I don't know if Chris ever lost consciousness.

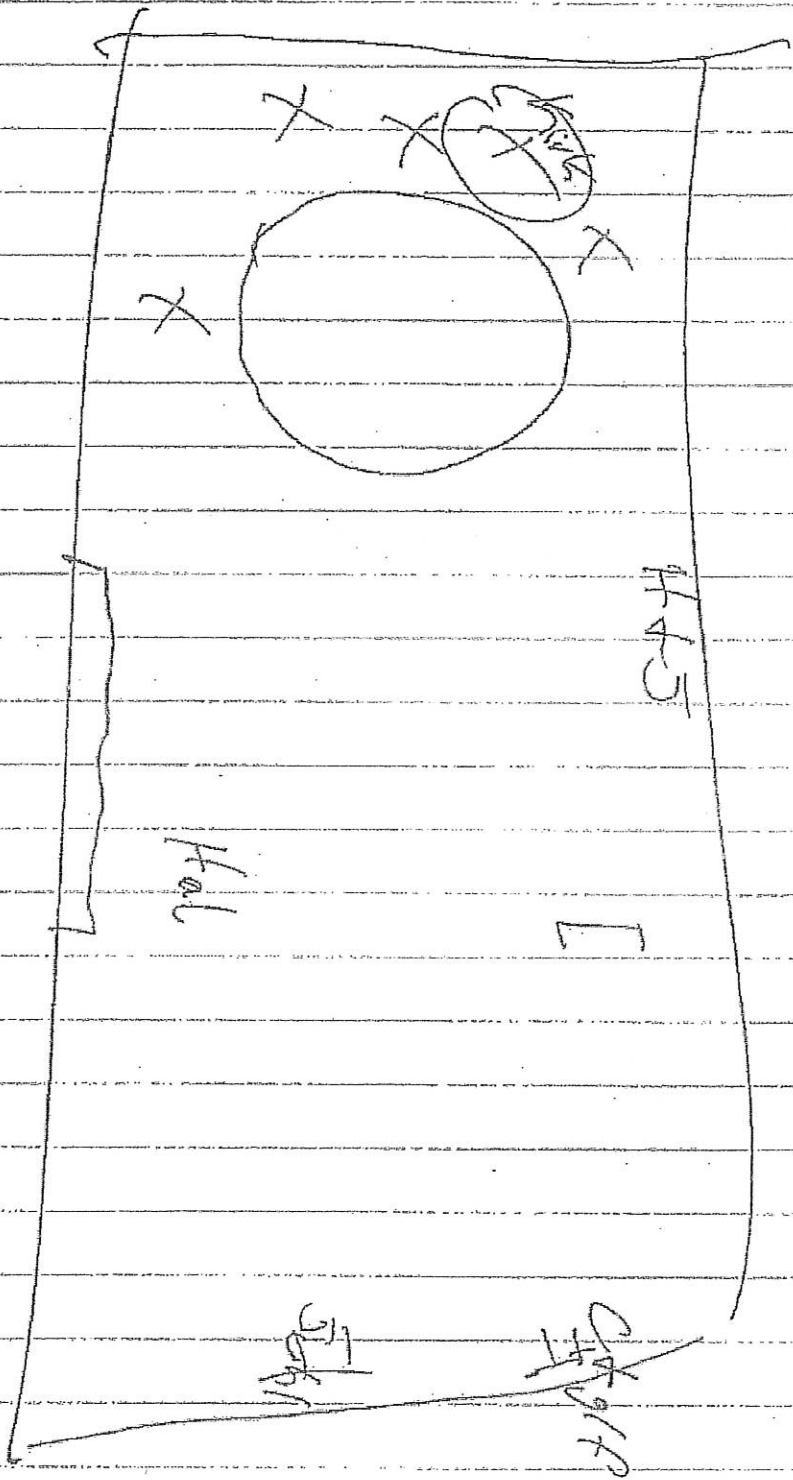
I figured there would be some kind of investigation into the circumstances involving Leigh's breasts being exposed. I decided to photograph Leigh and Chris so that if there was an investigation it would not have to rely solely on the memories of people who had been drinking. The picture mostly showed Chris and Leigh. It also showed Hal facing away from them and Matt and Jon's arms. It did not show all of Matt or Jon, but you can see that they were standing at the railing facing each other. After I took the first picture Matt and Jon noticed I was taking pictures, so they posed for a picture. I took a second picture showing Matt and Jon in the foreground, with Chris and Leigh in the background. It was a matter of seconds between shots.

After Chris and Leigh left Frannie told me that Chris had groped her. I talked to Edirin about it, telling him that I thought that the Leigh situation was inappropriate and that I thought nothing was going to happen because Chris was a senior DPA in the office. This was before I knew about what happened to Frannie. Edirin assured me something would happen. At his request I sent one of the photos to Craig Matheson. Edirin then went outside to talk to Chris. <sup>Craig's</sup>

I was sharing an Air B&B with my wife, Jon Cummings, Adam Sturdivant and his wife, and Laura Harmon. The next day I did talk to Adam and Laura about how crazy the evening got the night before. I told them

about Leigh's breasts being exposed and I showed them the pictures. I was not showing it to them because it was funny but because it was so shocking and inappropriate. I don't recall telling Laura or Adam that Chris had pulled Leigh's clothing off to expose her breasts. If Laura remembers that I said that it I might have said that. However it was more a function of me being less precise in a casual conversation than I am in an official investigation. I did not see how Leigh's breasts were exposed, and I cannot say that Chris was responsible for that. The next afternoon Matt Hunter asked that I delete the photo with him in it. I did so, including the copy of the text I sent to Craig.

## Statement of Mike Boska

On Wednesday June 20, 2018 I went to the hospitality room and had three drinks. I may have had one more beer later in the evening. I was feeling a little buzzed, but I was not drunk. I was able to function and able to see and remember what was going on.

After the hospitality room I went to dinner with a group of 11-12 people. Those people included Craig Matheson, Frannie Yahyavi, John Juhl, Miko Tempski, Marc Bides, Bob Hendrix, Chris Dickinson and his girlfriend, and Matt Hunter and his girlfriend Debbie. We first walked to one restaurant but that restaurant would not serve a group of people the size of our group. We ended up walking to a second restaurant. While we were walking to the restaurant I was talking to Chris Dickinson. Chris was commenting on how nice Leigh's breasts were. I don't think this comment was directed specifically at me. Chris told me that he and Leigh had an open relationship, which I took to mean that they were open to having other sexual partners. I thought Chris was buzzed too; his speech was not slurred, but he seemed looser, more happy.

We ate dinner at a brew pub type restaurant, and were seated at a big table. Frannie sat to my right. However Jon Cummings and Kirk Majoubian showed up for a while to talk while we were at the restaurant, but they did not eat with us. After we all ate Bob Hendrix left. We all sat around for another 20-30 minutes talking when I decided to leave too. I went back to my room and did not leave for the rest of the night. I did not see Chris interact with anyone at the other end of the table while there. I didn't see him try to get Frannie's attention. However because it was loud when I was there, I was talking to other people, and I left earlier than most people, I can't say that Chris did not do that.

On Thursday June 21 I did not see Chris at any of the classes. That night I went to a bar-b-que organized by Adam Cornell. I talked to Frannie and Bob Hendrix at the BBQ when the topic of what happened to Frannie the night before came up. That was the first time I heard that Chris had groped Frannie. The conversation started by talking about how crazy things got the night before. Frannie said that Chris grabbed her and that it was not ok. Frannie said that she was going to talk to Chris about it, but she did not ask me to be there when she did talk to him about it.

We talked about what happened to Frannie for about 15 minutes. Bob participated in the conversation. Bob agreed that what Chris did was not ok, and that should not have happened to Frannie. I don't recall Bob ever making light of the situation or suggesting that he should not sit next to Frannie in case she made a report that he had grabbed her or that she would report anything to get him in trouble. We did talk about what the resolution to this matter was going to be and wondered if Chris would be fired. This discussion was in the context of Frannie talking about wanting to talk to Chris. I do not recall Bob asking Frannie about whether she wanted to get Chris fired or not. I felt like Bob was really uncomfortable talking about this situation.

Frannie, Bob, and I also talked about where Chris was and whether he was ok. Someone had mentioned that Chris had taken a boat to the party at Edirin's and had boated back to the condo where he was staying. The concern was that Chris had fallen overboard and drowned.

On Friday morning I did see Chris with Leigh at the training. I asked Chris where he was the day before, telling him that they were worried about him. Chris said that he just took a day to R and R. Leigh was not with Chris during this conversation.



Statement of Laura Harmon


I went to the WAPA conference on June 20-22, 2018 in Chelan. I was sharing an Air B&B with Nate Sugg, Adam Sturdivant and his wife, Kirk Mahjoubian and his wife, and Jon Cummings. I did not go to the gathering at Edirin's hotel room on Wednesday night. I believe I was asleep at the time of the gathering at Edirin's room.

On Thursday morning while we were walking from our place to the conference Kirk asked me if I had heard about what happened the night before. He explained that he had been hanging out at Edirin Okoloko's room when he saw Chris Dickenson with Leigh on his lap. Kirk said that he saw Dickenson pull up Leigh's bra and just leave her like that. Kirk then showed me two photos on his phone. He did not say who took the photos.

The first photo showed Chris and Leigh. It also showed John Juhl sitting next to them passed out. The second photo also showed Chris and Leigh and John in the background. The foreground of the picture showed Matt Hunter and Jon Cummings. One of them had their thumbs up. I am fairly sure it was Jon. Jon and Matt had their arms around each other and were smiling. My impression was that they were framing themselves with what was going on in the background.

When Kirk talked to me about what happened with Leigh and Chris and showed me the photo, his tone was that the entire situation was really messed up, meaning this was a really serious situation. He was not making light of the situation.

Later on in the conference I heard someone say that Chris had groped Frannie. I don't remember who told me that, but I recall I was told during the day on Thursday.



I went to WAPA summer conference on June 20-22, 2018. My wife and I were staying in an Air B&B with Laura Harmon, Nate Sugg, Kirk Mahjoubian and his wife, and Jon Cummings. On Thursday Kirk, Nate, and Jon were talking about how things got a little weird the night before. They talked about Chris pulling up Leigh's shirt. No one said they actually saw Chris do that.

Kirk showed me photos of Chris and Leigh on the deck. Leigh's breasts were exposed. No one in the conversation, including Kirk, thought that the incident was funny. Everyone was flabbergasted and surprised that Chris would do that. The more we thought about it the more we realized how messed up and unacceptable the situation was.

Statement of Kameon Quillen

Sometime in May 2018 I was working in my office Chris Dickenson walked into my office. I was not expecting to see him. I was not working on any cases that he was involved in at the time. Chris had his phone with him and it looked like he wanted to show me something.

Chris started talking about the new boat they got and how they went out on their boat the prior weekend. Chris handed me his phone to see it. He did not have a picture of the boat displayed when he gave me the phone. Instead it was still showing his screen saver. The screen saver showed a woman laying on a bed with her arms above her. She was naked from the waist down. Her legs were open about 30 degrees and I could see her vaginal area. It seemed like she was sprawled on the bed. It looked like she had some ties on her wrists. It looked like the ties had been tied to something at one point, but may not still be tied to something, like an "after" picture. She was wearing high heels. I think that she was wearing some kind of top. Her head was turned about 45 degrees so she was slightly in profile. The picture was a monochromatic, sepia toned picture.

I originally thought that the photo was something he got off the internet. Then I realized the woman in the picture was Leigh Kellogg, Chris's girlfriend. I looked at Chris and said "this isn't your screen saver is it?" Chris said "yes" I asked him "does she know that you took this?" Chris said "yes" I told him that he should not have this as his screen saver. If this pops up in the courtroom other people could see it. Chris said "I think it's artistic" I told Chris this wasn't really not art, that I had a friend that took similar kinds of photos but not sexual like that one was. Chris just smiled, it seemed like he was really proud of it. I just turned away at that point and Chris never did show me a picture of the boat.

## Narrative

### NARRATIVE:

On 6/21/18 at 0045 hours, all times approximate, I, Deputy Tuengel, was working uniformed patrol in my marked patrol car in Chelan, WA. I was dispatched to a possible theft at 60 South Lake Shore RD. The reporting party believed a theft of kayaks was actively occurring. I was advised the suspects arrived by boat and were attempting to leave.

I arrived in the area and observed a female operating an open cabin runabout vessel displaying expired state ID number (WN1146RI). Her swim suit was wrapped around her neck and it appeared her head was placed through the arm hole of her sun dress. Her breasts were clearly visible and in no way covered by any of her clothing. It appeared they were protruding through the opening of the dress designed for one's head. I observed the female driver place the vessel in reverse and stumble to the deck of the vessel. I immediately began to fear the vessel would collide with the dock. The female driver later identified as KELLOGG, LEIGH (10/07/1981) was somehow able to place the boat into forward gear to prevent a collision. She had fallen over and managed to do this from a partially lying position. I identified myself as law enforcement and instructed her to place the vessel in neutral. The action I had just observed lead me to believe she and anyone around the vessel was in extreme danger.

She appeared to acknowledge me, however she continued to operate the vessel in this extremely dangerous manner. Her movements were very rigid and sloppy. She began to drive into the dock and I was only able to prevent a collision by using physical strength to stop the boat from colliding with the dock.

I needed to make contact with KELLOGG on the vessel to stop the vessel. This became even more important to prevent her from driving as I noticed a kayaker was immediately in front of the vessel. I believed the kayaker was in imminent danger of being struck by the vessel.

Once on board I immediately smelled a strong odor of intoxicants coming from KELLOGG's breath. Her eyes were watery and her face was flushed. KELLOGG's speech was extremely slurred and all of her responses were very delayed. She could not find any documents I requested. She was not able to stand without falling over. KELLOGG's balance was so poor and her actions so unusual I was in fear she could fall out of the boat. The water during this contact was calm and the boat was a stable platform.

KELLOGG was instructed to exit the vessel and come to land. I had to hold onto KELLOGG to prevent her from falling off the dock and in the water. She was not able to walk in a straight line.

I asked if KELLOGG would perform Voluntary Standardized Field Sobriety Test and she agreed. Using my Standardized Field Sobriety Testing Instructions and Clues card as a reference I conducted a voluntary field sobriety test. To conduct the tests I moved KELLOGG to solid ground.

HGN

I conducted the Horizontal gaze nystagmus test. I confirmed she understood the test. I did not observe resting nystagmus in either eye, each pupil was of equal size and each eye equally tracked. I observed lack of smooth pursuit in both eyes. I observed nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. I observed nystagmus onset prior to 45 degrees in both eyes. All observed nystagmus was distinct and obvious and I confirmed the results of what I was seeing. KELLOGG was not able to stand without swaying during the test and almost fell over during testing. She was asked to sit down so I could complete the test.

WALK & TURN

During the Walk and Turn test KELLOGG could not maintain her balance. She started the test too soon. She walked off the line. She needed to use her arms for balance. I needed to stay close to KELLOGG as I feared she might fall over. After completing eight steps I stopped the test because I felt she was no longer be able to safely walk down the line without falling.

ONE LEG STAND

I did not ask KELLOGG to perform the One Leg Stand test out of fear KELLOGG would fall over.

Preliminary Breath Test (PBT)

I asked KELLOGG if she would be willing to submit a breath sample to my department issued preliminary breath test (PBT) advising the test was voluntary and non-evidentiary if used in court. KELLOGG told me she would provide a sample. I observed KELLOGG did not consume any alcohol during my contact with her and I waited until fifteen minutes had passed before I conducted the test. She provided a preliminary breath sample of .191 BAC.

During this test the male in the Kayak, DICKINSON, CHRISTOPHER JOHN walked to the location. He began to yell at KELLOGG to not cooperate with law enforcement. KELLOGG expressed that she did not want his advice. DICKINSON began to yell at me and claimed he was a Snohomish County Prosecutor and I needed to listen to him. He began to demand that I acknowledge that he was a lawyer. KELLOGG was very clear that she did not want to follow his advice and appeared to be embarrassed by his actions. DICKINSON attempted to rush my location when KELLOGG told me she was willing to provide a voluntary breath sample. DICKINSON was prevented from interring by having Deputy Soreano make him step back.

ADMINISTRATIVE PROCESS

Based on my observations I placed KELLOGG under arrest for Boating Under the Influence. She was placed in properly adjusted and double locked handcuffs and put into the back of my patrol car. She was read her constitutional rights off of my CJTC issued Miranda Rights card. She was transported to the Chelan Office for the administrative portion of the BUI process without incident.

I started the Draeger warm up process. I read KELLOGG her Miranda Rights directly from the Washington State DUI Arrest Report to which she stated she understood and that she was willing to talk with me. KELLOGG requested an attorney. I contacted Chelan Public defender David Force for KELLOGG and gave her the phone. After KELLOGG completed the phone call I asked if she would provide a breath sample. KELLOGG did not express any confusion when she stated she would provide a breath sample. After the 15 minute observation period I processed her on the Draeger Alcotest in accordance with my training. KELLOGG provided 2 valid breath samples on the Draeger. The first measured IR .260 / EC .266 BAC and the second measured IR .262 / EC .268 BAC.

KELLOGG was issued citation# 8Z0430470 for RCW 79a.60.040.2 Operating a Vessel Under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs. KELLOGG was cited and released without incident. She was given a courtesy ride to the condo she was staying in.

## Narrative

### NARRATIVE:

On June 21, 2018 at approximately 0047 hours Deputy Tuengel and myself arrived on scene to a report of a possible theft in progress. The reporting party, identified as McNett, Paul, S. (01/31/1953) advised a male had gotten off a boat and was walking through the property and found a kayak and was walking back toward the boat. Paul advised Rivercom he believed the male was stealing the kayak.

Deputy Tuengel and I arrived on scene and contacted a female, identified as Kellogg, Leigh, M. (10/07/1981) driving a boat attempting to secure it to the dock. A male was also contacted, later identified by his WA state driver's license as Dickinson, Christopher, J. (01/18/1963). Christopher was located in a kayak near Leigh. Christopher was attempting to row the kayak with his hands. Christopher was able paddle to the dock with his hands. As Christopher pulled himself up to the dock I could smell a strong odor of intoxicants coming from his person, and I could see his eyes were bloodshot and watery. Once on the dock Christopher had difficulty keeping his balance. I had to assist Christopher with pulling up the kayak on the dock for fear Christopher would fall in the water due to his level of intoxication.

While Deputy Tuengel spoke with Leigh, Christopher advised me he and Leigh had a few drinks earlier in the evening. Christopher informed just the two of them were staying in a condo nearby. He advised Leigh was trying to drive the boat to the dock so she could drop him off.

While Christopher spoke to me Christopher had slurred speech, and had difficulty speaking due to his level of intoxication.

Deputy Tuengel and myself walked Leigh and Christopher up to where our patrol cars were parked. While walking, Christopher had difficulty keeping his balance, at one point he nearly fell into a raised landscaping area.

While Deputy Tuengel observed Leigh perform voluntary field sobriety tests Christopher become very agitated and started yelling at Leigh not to do a fucking thing. Christopher began to move closer towards Deputy Tuengel and myself as Leigh was performing field sobriety tests. I asked Christopher to step back several times to my patrol car. Christopher informed me he was a lawyer and was representing Leigh. At no point did Leigh inform Deputy Tuengel or myself Christopher was her lawyer. Leigh was ultimately placed into custody for Boating Under the Influence.

On June 21, 2018 at approximately 0246 hours, I was on routine uniformed patrol in the Chelan area. At this time, I was at the Chelan substation, while walking to my patrol car I immediately recognized Christopher in the driver's seat of a parked vehicle, identified with WA AKA6157. The vehicle was parked in reserved Sheriff's deputies parking and was parked outside the lines of the parking space. I made a field contact on the vehicle and saw it was indeed Christopher. Christopher informed me he was waiting for his girlfriend, Leigh to be released. Christopher informed me a friend had driven him to the office and walked back to the hotel. Christopher stated he would not tell me his friend's name. As Christopher spoke I could smell the strong odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. I observed Christopher's eyes were bloodshot and watery. Christopher denied he had driven the vehicle, he was only sitting in the driver's seat with the keys in the ignition.

I asked Christopher if he would be willing to perform voluntary field sobriety tests, Christopher said he would. I told him the first voluntary test I would be looking at his eyes. I first checked Christopher's eyes for equal tracking, equal pupil size, and resting nystagmus, and all appeared normal. I then checked his eyes for lack of smooth pursuit. As he followed my pen I observed both eyes "twitch" or "bounce". Next, I checked his eyes for distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation. As he followed my pen to maximum deviation I again observed both eyes "twitch" or "bounce". I then checked his eyes for onset

of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. As he followed my pen I again observed both eyes "twitch" or "bounce" prior to 45 degrees.

The next voluntary test I asked Christopher to perform was the walk and turn. I instructed him to stand with his right foot in front of his left foot with his hands down at his sides until I instructed him to begin the test. While reading the instructions Christopher was unable to keep his balance and had to catch himself with his right foot. I demonstrated this portion to ensure Christopher understood, after demonstrating it Christopher stated he understood. During the first series of steps Christopher stepped off line twice and missed heel to toe three times. Christopher performed an improper turn, he did not keep his front foot planted and pivot on it as instructed. During the second series of steps I did not observe any clues.

The next voluntary test I asked Christopher to perform was the one leg stand. I first explained the test to him and then demonstrated it for him. During the test Christopher put his foot down twice and swayed approximately six inches to the left and right while balancing for the entire test.

The last voluntary test I asked Christopher to submit to was to provide a voluntary breath sample into a Portable Breath Tester(PBT). I asked Christopher if he had anything to drink within the last 15 minutes, Christopher stated no. Chris stated he was not willing to provide a voluntary sample.

Based on my observations I advised Christopher he was under arrest for Physical Control and placed him into handcuffs, which were gauged and double locked. I walked Christopher into the Chelan substation and advised him of his Miranda warnings from my department issued card, he said he understood his rights. Deputy Sutton stood by with the vehicle until Stormin Towing arrived and took custody of it.

I removed Christopher from handcuffs and conducted a mouth check at 0305 hours. There were no foreign substances in his mouth. From this time until the completion of the testing process I observed Christopher. He did not vomit, eat, drink, smoke, or place any foreign objects into his mouth during this time.

I advised Christopher of his Constitutional rights from the WA State DUI Arrest Packet. He signed acknowledging he understood and wished to invoke his rights. Christopher advised he did not wish to speak to a lawyer. I advised Christopher of the Implied Consent Warning for Breath from the WA State DUI Packet for RCW 46.61.504. I read him the warnings verbatim. Christopher advised he understood the warnings, signing the document.

I input all the information into the Draeger BAC instrument and verified the breath tube was warm to the touch. I instructed Christopher to blow into the mouthpiece and give a deep and full breath. Christopher provided 2 valid breath samples on the Draeger. The first measured IR .154 / EC .156 BAC. The second measured IR .154/ EC .157 BAC.

Christopher was transported and booked into CCRJC under citation 8Z0683728 for RCW 46.61.504 Physical Control.

The undersigned on oath states: That affiant believes that the crime(s) of **RCW 46.61.504 Physical Control** has (have) been committed by the defendant.

The affiant's belief is based on the following facts and circumstances: **On June 21, 2018 at approximately 0246 hours, I, Deputy Soreano was on routine uniformed patrol in the Chelan area of Chelan County for Chelan County Sheriff's Office. At this time, I was at the Chelan substation, while walking to my patrol car I recognized a subject from a previous call (reference case #18C06285) sitting in a parked vehicle in the Chelan substation parking lot, I recognized the subject and made a field contact on the vehicle, identified with WA AKA6157.**

Upon contacting the subject, who previously identified himself with his WA state driver's license as **Dickinson, Christopher, J. (01/18/1963)** stated he was waiting for his girlfriend. As Chris spoke I could smell the strong odor of intoxicants coming from the vehicle. I observed Chris's eyes were bloodshot and watery. Chris informed me a friend had driven the vehicle and parked it and walked back to the hotel. Chris stated he had not driven the vehicle he was only sitting in the driver's seat with the keys in the ignition. Chris admitted to drinking earlier in the night.

I asked Chris if he would be willing to perform voluntary field sobriety tests, Chris said he would. I told him the first voluntary test I would be looking at his eyes. I first checked Chris's eyes for equal tracking, equal pupil size, and resting nystagmus, and all appeared normal. I then checked his eyes for lack of smooth pursuit. As he followed my pen I observed his eyes "twitch" or "bounce". I observed this in both the left and right eye. Next, I checked his eyes for distinct and sustained nystagmus at maximum deviation. As he followed my pen to maximum deviation I again observed his eyes "twitch" or "bounce". I observed this in both the left and right eye. I then checked his eyes for onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees. As he followed my pen I again observed his eyes "twitch" or "bounce" prior to 45 degrees. I observed this in both the left and right eye.

The next voluntary test I asked Chris to perform was the walk and turn. I instructed him to stand with his right foot in front of his left foot with his hands down at his sides until I instructed him to begin the test. I demonstrated this portion to ensure Chris understood, after demonstrating it Chris stated he understood. During the first series of steps Chris stepped off line and missed heel to toe. Chris performed an improper turn, and during the second series of steps I did not observe any clues.

The next voluntary test I asked Chris to perform was the one leg stand. I first explained the test to him and then demonstrated it for him. During the test Chris put his foot down and swayed approximately six inches in to the left and right while balancing.

The last voluntary test I asked Chris to submit to was to provide a voluntary breath sample into a Portable Breath Tester(PBT). I asked Chris if he had anything to drink within the last 15 minutes, Chris stated no. Chris stated he was not willing to provide a voluntary sample.

Based on my observations I advised Chris he was under arrest for Physical Control and placed him into handcuffs, which were gauged and double locked. I walked Chris into the Chelan substation and advised him of his Miranda warnings from my department issued card, he said understood his rights. Deputy Sutton stood by with the vehicle until Stormin Towing arrived and took custody of it.

I removed Chris from handcuffs and conducted a mouth check at 0305 hours. There were no foreign substances in his mouth. From this time until the completion of the testing process I observed Chris. He did not vomit, eat, drink, smoke, or place any foreign objects into his mouth during this time.

I advised Chris of his Constitutional rights from the WA State DUI Arrest Packet. He signed acknowledging he understood and wished to invoked his rights. Chris advised he did not wish to speak to a lawyer. I advised Chris of the Implied Consent Warning for Breath from the WA State DUI Packet for RCW 46.61.504. I read him the warnings verbatim. Chris advised he understood the warnings, signing the document.

I input all the information into the Draeger BAC instrument and verified the breath tube was warm to the touch. I instructed Chris to blow into the mouthpiece and give a deep and full breath. Chris provided 2 valid breath samples on the Draeger. The first measured IR .154 / EC .156 BAC. The second measured IR .154/ EC .157 BAC.

Chris was transported and booked into CCRJC and issued Sector criminal traffic citation 8Z0683728 for RCW 46.61.504 Physical Control

Based on the above facts there is probable cause for the arrest of Dickinson, Christopher, J. (01/18/1963) for RCW 46.61.504 Physical Control
